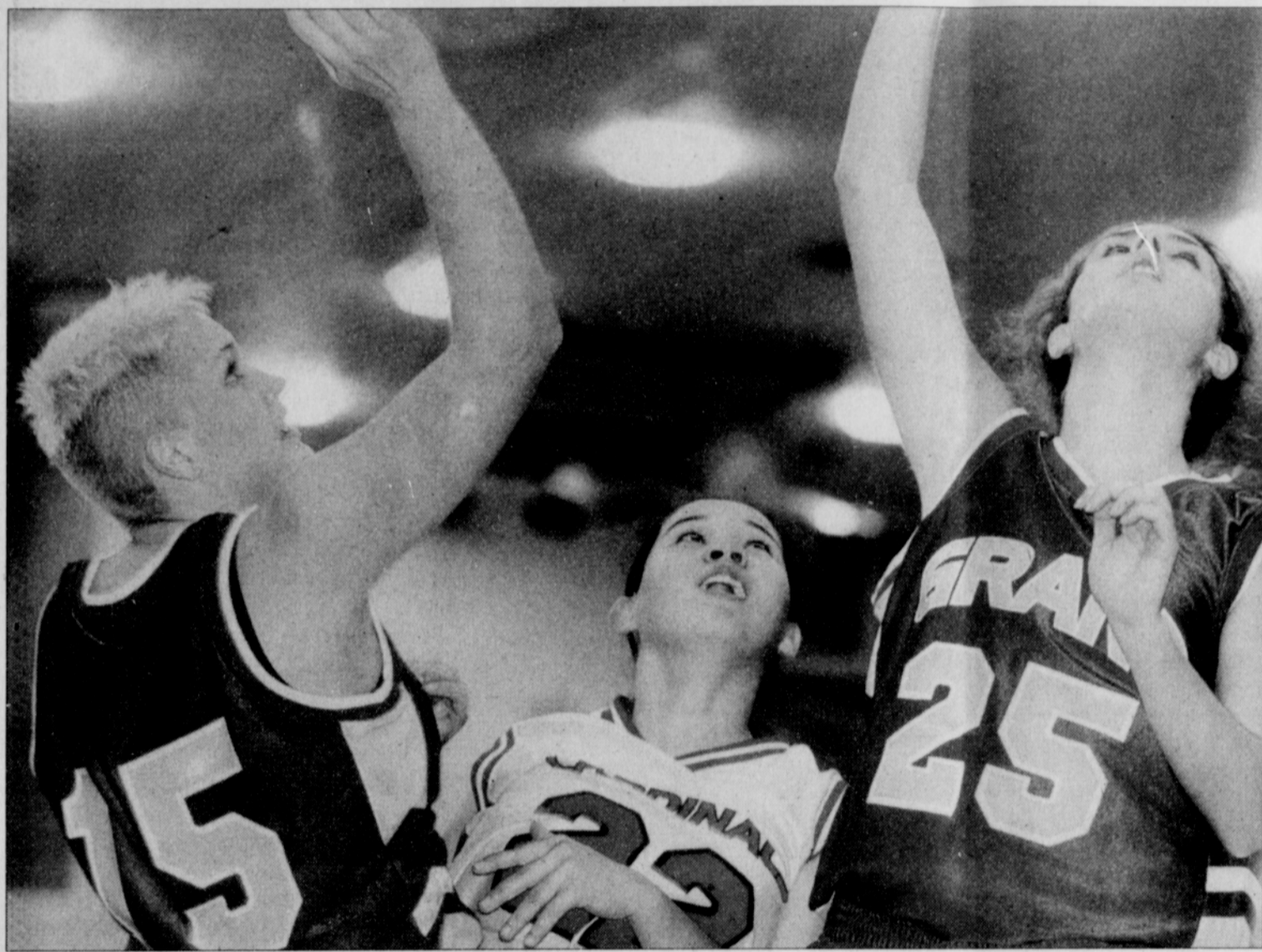

PATRIOTS WIN SUPERBOWL

(AP) - A team that overcame so much wouldn't let more long odds stop them.

The New England Patriots had 1:21 and no timeouts left. The ball was at their 17-yard line and the score was tied at 17. The safe approach would have been to run out the clock and take their chances in overtime.

Instead, they went for the win Sunday and got it, 20-17 over the St. Louis Rams on Adam Vinatieri's last-play, 48-yard field goal.

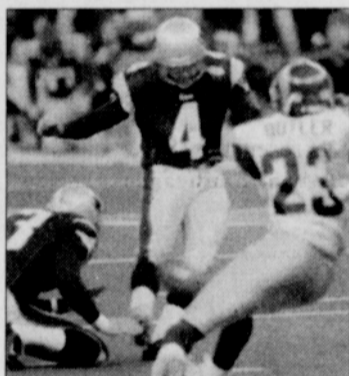
"Our goal was to move the ball down the field to get into field-goal range," quarterback Tom

Brady said. "I was planning to go out there and win the game."

He completed five of eight passes on the drive for 53 yards. Two of the incompletes were spikes to stop the clock. The other was thrown out of bounds when he was under pressure.

The first three completions went to J.R. Redmond for 5, 8 and 11 yards. That gave the Patriots a first down at their 41-yard line with 33 seconds left.

The biggest play was a 23-yard completion to Troy Brown to the Rams 36, and he went out of bounds with 21 seconds to go.
