Notice is hereby given that a public hearing, if so requested by any interested person, will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) in Conference Room A, 4012 SE 17th Avenue, Portland at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, March 13, 2002. The purpose of the hearing is to consider a project for which federal FY02 \$5309 funds from the Federal Transit Administration is being sought for Tri-Met's ongoing capital program.
