Briefly, the work consists of replacing primary voltage feeders, building transformers, secondary service equipment, installation of medium voltage switchgear, and associated steel fabrication, concrete, and finish work.

City Of La Center West Third Street Reconstruction

Sealed proposals for furnishing all materials, labor and equipment for the following described work will be received by the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of La Center, 214 E. 4th Street, La Center, Washington 98629 up until 3:00 pm Thursday, May 2nd, 2002. At this time the sealed bids will be publicly opened and read. A contract will be awarded or all bids rejected within 60 days after the bid opening.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project includes the following work:

- Demolition, removal, haul and disposal of existing roadway pavement.
- Clearing, grubbing, tree removal, roadway excavation and embankment and subgrade preparation.
- Construction of approximately 400 linear feet of 12-inch, 200 linear feet of 15-inch, and 290 linear feet of 18-inch storm drain pipe to include catch basins, manholes and connections. This work will also include the installation of a Stormgate and Storm filter Vault for storm water treatment.
- Widening and reconstruction of approximately 1,200 linear feet of asphalt concrete pavement roadway including cement concrete curb, gutter, sidewalks and permanent signing and striping.
- Excavation, erection, and backfill of 650 feet of Ultra Block Retaining Wall.
