## Hollywood Library to Close and Relocate

Multnomah County's Hollywood Library will close at 6 p.m. on Saturday, April 20 and reopen in a new location at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, May 7.

The library's new location is the ground floor of a new mixed-use building at 4040 N.E. Tillamook St. Multnomah County Library

owns the library portion of the building, while its partner Sock-eye Hollywood, LLC owns The Bookmark Apartments on the building's three upper floors, as well as an 815-square-foot, ground-floor retail space.

At 13,000 square feet, the new library is about double the size of

the current library building. The new library will feature original art, a 50-seat meeting room and new computers and furnishings.

During the two weeks that Hollywood Library is closed, customers may pick up their reserved books and other items at the staff entrance to the old location, 3930

N.E. Hancock St. The staff entrance is on Hancock St. to the west of the main doors. Pick-up times will be from April 24-May 5. Hours are from 4-7 p.m., Tuesday through Friday; and 1-4 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
