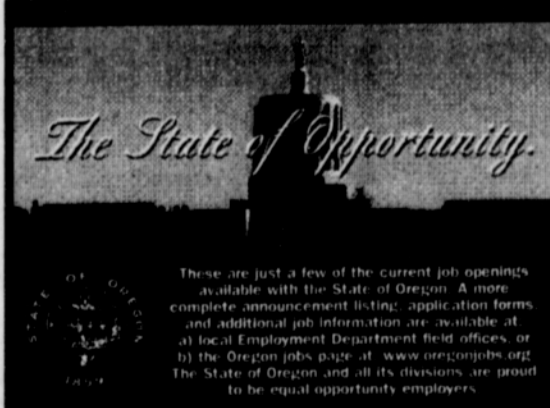

Sealed Bids for the OCC-Concession Stand "B" Project, must be delivered to MERC Offices at 777 N.E. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Portland, OR 97232 to the attention of Mark Hunter, Project Manager, no later than 3:00PM Pacific Time, Tuesday, June 4, 2002. At that time, the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the MERC Conference Room.

The Work contemplated consists of all equipment, materials, and labor as necessary to remodel the existing Concession Stand in accordance with the construction documents. The location of the work will be at 777 NE MLK Jr. Blvd., Portland, OR 97232.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or cashiers check, or Bid Bond executed on the prescribed form, payable to MERC in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid amount. Successful Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bonds for the faithful performance of the Contract and for the payment of all persons supplying labor and materials as prescribed in the Contract Documents.

This is a public works project. By signing and submitting a Bid for this project, the Bidder certifies that it will comply with ORS 279.350, requiring payment of prevailing wage rates. Bidders must also use recyclable products to the maximum extent economically feasible in the performance of the contract work and be registered with the Oregon Construction Contractor's Board pursuant to ORS 701.035-90. Each Bid must contain a statement as to whether the Bidder is a resident bidder, as defined in ORS 279.029. Bidders must also comply with MERC's Minority Business Enterprise, Women-Owned Business Enterprise, and Emerging Small Business Program.

A Pre-Bids Conference will be conducted on Monday, May 20, 2002 at 10:30AM Pacific Time, to begin at the MERC Administrative Offices in the Oregon Convention Center. This Conference will include a site tour and inspection opportunity for the intended areas of work.

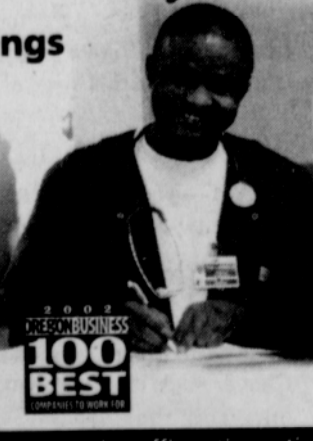
