This Request for Proposal (RFP) is the initial step toward the selection of a pre-qualified **Pool of Demolition Contractors** to perform all services necessary to demolish and remove from their sites up to fourteen houses located near PCC's Cascade Campus. These houses either have been purchased or are in the process of being purchased by PCC to make room for the future expansion of the campus. The College intends to competitively quote the demolition of each house or specific groups of houses exclusively to this pool once a house has been identified to be demolished. The successful contractor will be required to provide a guaranteed maximum price based on a scope of work to be defined. Contracts will be awarded to the lowest pool bidder for each added house/houses accordingly.

PCC encourages demolition/de-construction techniques that maximize reuse of existing materials to the greatest extent possible.

**PCC will file the thirty-five (35) day demolition delay notice with the City as required.**

State of Oregon Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works Contracts in Oregon shall be utilized for all labor involved in this Contract, including Wage Rates and Certification of payroll as required by the Bureau of Labor & Industries (BOLI).

All contractors shall be registered with the Construction Contractors Board or licensed by the State Landscape Contractors Board as required by ORS 671.530.

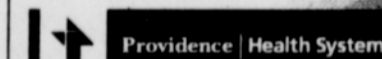
