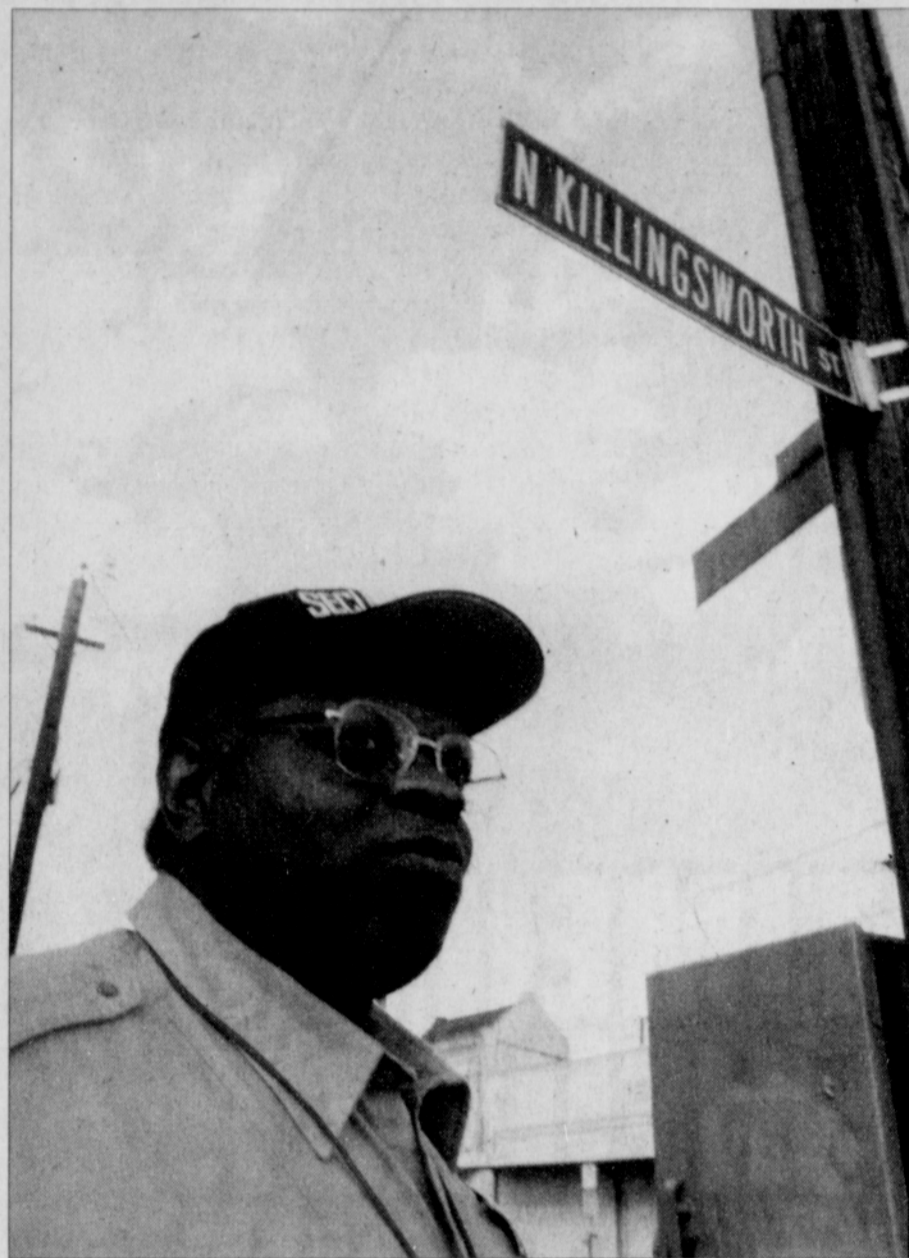


Not In My Neighborhood

 occasionally runs deep enough to change the direction of the lives he comes in contact with. He recently talked a former prostitute into returning to school at Portland Community College.
 Local law enforcement officers are supportive and impressed with his results.
 "The police are absolutely amazed," Jenkins said.

His effectiveness at cleaning up the streets has been noticed by PCC's Cascade Campus as well.
 Much of the area is owned by the college or lies within its expansion plan.
 He has approached the college about contracting services to patrol Albina south of Killingsworth where several vacant houses owned by the college have been broken into.

Jenkins thinks the partnership would be positive for PCC and the neighborhood.
 Jenkins has made such a difference outside his own apartment building, that he is beginning to lighten the frequency of his patrols. He thinks it all comes down to community livability and personal accountability.
 "I would really like to see more people show respect for themselves and each other," he said.

Weaver Past Probed For Victims

 Weaver was arrested on Aug. 13 on charges of raping his 19-year-old son's girlfriend. His distraught son, Francis Weaver, told emergency dispatchers after the alleged rape that his father had admitted killing Ashley and Miranda.
 "I'm sorry that any of this even happened," Francis Weaver said Tuesday on "Good Morning America." "I hope that now that (the girls' families) have closure and everything, they can go on with their lives and live their lives as good as they can."
 He would not give specifics on why he believes his father killed the girls, saying public

comment could hinder prosecutors' efforts.
 The younger Weaver said he would have called 911 even without the alleged rape.
 "It was inevitable," Francis Weaver said. "My father probably knew that I was to come forward, and he just did that as a grand finale to his sick scheme."
 Last summer, Ashley had accused Ward Weaver of molesting her, but he denied the allegations and was never charged. Family members and friends have said they had a close, and at times inappropriate, relationship.
 Weaver's father, Ward Francis Weaver Jr., is on death row in California for two murders. A raped and murdered woman's body was found buried in his yard in 1982.

Honored for Political Integrity

She cast lone vote in Bush's war resolution after Sept. 11

(AP) — When California Rep. Barbara Lee cast the lone vote against war in the aftermath of Sept. 11, she was threatened and accused of treason.
 She found a much more sympathetic audience Sunday in Eugene, where she became only the second woman to receive the Wayne Morse Integrity in Politics Award.
 The award goes to an elected official who demonstrates political courage, integrity and independence. It honors the memory of former Oregon Sen. Wayne Morse, one of only two senators who voted in 1964 against the war in Vietnam.
 Lee said she voted against

President Bush's war resolution because it was a "blank check" that usurped congressional powers and the Constitution.
 "It gave the president the authority to use force against any nation, organization or individual that the administration deemed necessary," she said.
 "There was no time frame, no organization mentioned, no country."
 "I believe that while we must fight terrorism, we cannot engage in actions that could spiral out of control and lead to more violence and deaths."
 Of course, most Americans disagreed with her. And some of them let her know.
 University of Oregon, said people can never know when they may become a footnote to history.
 "People don't plan to be famous, but the fact is that sometimes there are pivotal moments in our history when someone stands up and speaks out," Piercy said. "It can make a great difference in the way we proceed as a country."
 Lee compared Morse, who at 31 was the youngest dean ever at the UO Law School, to Martin Luther King Jr. and Gandhi.
 "He was ahead of his time," she said. "He was larger than life. He's still larger than life. To receive this award based on the life and work of this man has been quite humbling for me."
