## REQUEST FOR BIDDER PREQUALIFICATION PROPOSALS Stormwater Sediment Remediation and Recycling Services

The City of Portland requests proposals for bidder prequalification for stormwater sediment remediation and recycling services. The prequalification process consists of a) review of the bidder's methods to confirm that they meet the City's environmental needs, and b) a trial of the bidder's remediation technology on a test batch of the City's sediment. Before and after sampling and chemical testing for a specific suite of contaminants will be performed on the trial batch to confirm the effectiveness of the bidder's technology at remediating the City's sediment to the City's standards.

Proposals must include a general description of the bidder's remediation and recycling methods and technology, and the name, address, and phone number of bidder's business representative for purposes of completing the prequalification process. Proposals must be submitted in writing or by fax to City of Portland, Bureau of Purchasing. Proposals for the 2002 bidding process must be received no later than 4:00 pm September 20, 2002. Announcement of the City's bid process for stormwater sediment remediation and recycling services is anticipated to follow on or about October 1.

The following businesses have already prequalified: TPS Technologies, Inc., Rivergate; United Soil Recycling, Woodburn.

The Miracle Group launches its 18<sup>th</sup> season with the Oregon premiere of "La Chunga," a play by Mario Vargas Llosa that in 1980 became a milestone of Latin-American literature and is a force of innovation in theatre.

In northern Peru, the word "Chunga" is used to describe a woman at the bottom of the socio-economic ladder. La Chunga owns a seedy bar in Piura where she can be found every day bartending and watching the regulars gamble.

The bar's regulars are a group of machista men who call themselves the "High Stud Champs;" they taunt La Chunga mercilessly, but so far they have known where to draw the line.

One night, the town pimp Josefino brings in his latest conquest, the beautiful Meche. She is

in line to become la Casa Verde's next whore, if Josefino gets his way.

La Chunga can't keep her eyes off of Meche. While gambling, Josefino loses big and offers La Chunga a dirty deal if she will give him money to stay in the game. The deal is that Meche must spend the night with La Chunga doing anything she asks. In the morning, Meche is gone and never seen again.

Did La Chunga spend that long night convincing Meche to run away, or did she discover desires of her own? La Chunga will never tell, not even for a million soles.

Among experts who follow political campaigns, no one can remember a tandem like this. Supporters hail Kirk and Sanchez as "the dream team." The candidates — both affluent, well-connected to the conservative Texas business establishment, and trying to appeal to a broad spectrum of voters — deliberately eschew the label. "I'm not running as a Hispanic," Sanchez tells a reporter. "The fact that I'm African-American is irrelevant," insists Kirk.

Maybe it is to Texas voters, maybe not. But in terms of national politics, Sanchez and Kirk represent something unprecedented.
