Written amounts shall be shown in both words and figures. Words shall govern in cases of discrepancy between the amounts stated in words and the amount stated in figures.

All bids must be on the form furnished by Metro or they may be rejected by Metro. Where plans and specifications are attached to the bid, they must be returned by the Bidder with the bid.

All bidders must be registered with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board pursuant to ORS 671.530.
