## PORT OF KALAMA NOTICE ARCHITECTURAL & ENGINEERING SERVICES

Pursuant to RCW 39.80, the Port of Kalama gives notice of its projected requirements for the period January 1 through December 31, 2003 for the following categories and/or types of professional services:

- Civil/Structural/Mechanical/Electrical.**  
Design and construction supervision of new and rehabilitated buildings for industrial and/or commercial uses including excavation and site preparation; sewage treatment facilities; transportation facilities for ship, road, and railroad including intermodal connections; and warehouses.
- Planning.**  
Preparation of plans and/or studies concerning the development of marine export/import terminals, industrial parks, bulk material and ro-ro export/import facilities. This includes consideration of various transportation modes including deep water shipping.
- Geotechnical.**  
Study and investigation of ground conditions at various industrial sites to determine the desirability and acceptability for facility construction including ground water and soil contamination issues.
- SEPA/Permitting/Regulatory Compliance.**  
Compliance with SEPA, acquisition of permits in relation to Port developments, and compliance with hazardous materials/waste and underground storage tank laws and regulations.
- Recreation.**  
Investigation, design, and supervision of: expansion of pedestrian/bicycle pathways, interpretive centers, and boardwalks; restaurants, and, construction of additional facilities associated with a small boat marina, including additional docking.
- Hydraulic/Marine.**  
Hydraulic investigations of the Columbia River; study, investigation, and design of facilities related to river projects including but not limited to riprap, construction of docks and wharfs, pilings, ramps, and tie-up and anchorage facilities; evaluation and development of long-term plans for dredge disposal.
- Environmental.**  
Evaluation, design, preparation, and execution of studies and construction of projects relating to environmental issues including sediment quality, water quality, wetlands, wildlife habitat, and other issues affecting port development.
- Surveying/Civil.**  
Investigation and preparation of maps, aerial photographs, plat plans, and other work to facilitate the orderly development of the Port.
- Economic and Marketing Consultant.**  
Perform market research as part of a port marketing plan. Such research shall include economic analysis (business/industry cycles and trends) and market analysis.
- Many of the above mentioned categories/types overlap within a particular project. The above descriptions are brief and include unmentioned but necessary related aspects of the individual projects.

All persons wishing to be considered to supply services during the period from January 1, through December 31, 2003 must submit a statement of qualifications as well as a listing of work performed in any of the above-referenced items to the Port of Kalama on or before December 27, 2002. Metro is soliciting new bids for construction of a maintenance facility for the St. Johns Landfill located in the vicinity of 9387 N. Columbia Blvd., Portland, Oregon 97203. Sealed bids must be delivered to Metro, Regional Environmental Management Department (REM), 600 NE Grand Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97232 to the attention of Pete Hillmann, Project Manager, no later than 11:00 am PST, on December 3, 2002. At that time, the Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in Conference Room 270 located in the Metro Regional Center.

Drawings and Specification may be examined at the REM Department in the Metro Regional Center, OAME Plan Center, located at 4134 N. Vancouver Ave, Portland, Oregon 97217, or the DJC Plan Center. Copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained at the REM Department or by calling (503) 797-1650.

A Pre-Bid Conference for prospective Bidders will be conducted in Room 370B located at Metro Regional Center, Portland, Oregon on Tuesday, November 19, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. Attendance at this meeting is mandatory for all potential prime bidders to comply with Metro's Minority, Women-Owned and Emerging Small Business Enterprise Program. A site visit is planned immediately following the meeting.

All contractors must submit a form in its bid submission or within four (4) working hours after bid closing listing all first tier subcontractors supplying labor, or labor and materials with a contract amount greater than or equal to: 1) 5% of the project base bid, but at least \$15,000, or 2) \$350,000 regardless of the percentage.

In addition to the sealed bids, all contractors must complete and submit all the supplied forms for Metro's MBE/WBE/ESB Program (Good Faith Efforts) and for listing first tier subcontractors, in a separate envelope, within four (4) hours of bid closing (or before 3:00 p.m.). All other Bid Forms must be filled out and included with the "sealed bids" at time of closing.

Metro Code provisions 2.04.100 and 200 require all Bidders/Proposers to follow and document a specific good faith outreach effort to State certified Minority, Emerging and Women-owned Businesses. Certification of good faith compliance and a declaration of any actual utilization pursuant to both programs are required at the time of Bid Opening/Proposal Submission.

All bidders must certify that they will pay and comply with the minimum prevailing wage requirements of ORS 279.350.

All bidders must be registered with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board pursuant to ORS 671.530.

Metro and its contractors will not discriminate against any person(s) based on race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, age, religion, physical handicap, political affiliation or marital status.

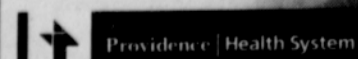
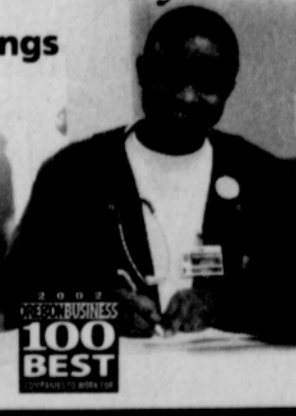

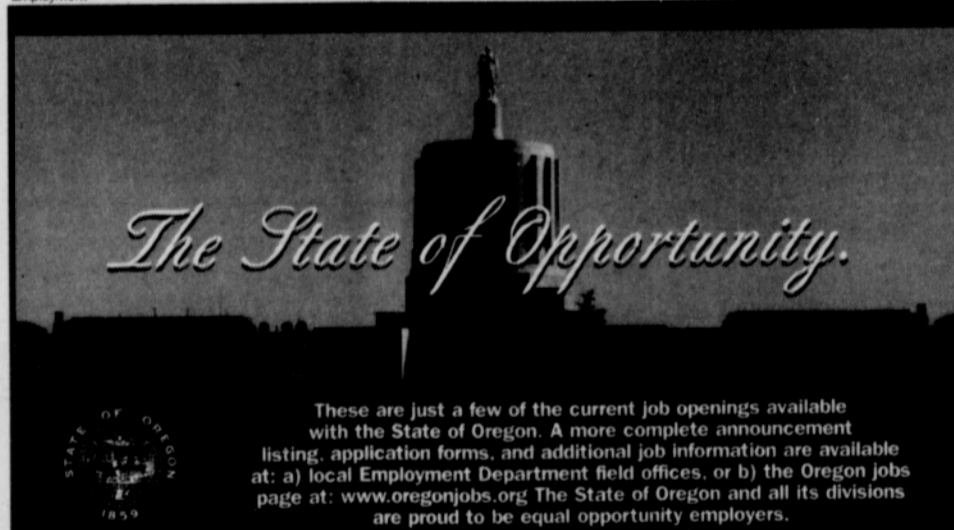
