The Solid Waste and Recycling Department of Metro, a metropolitan service district organized under the laws of the State of Oregon and the Metro Charter, is requesting proposals for supplying reconditioned 55-gallon drums (RFB #03-1059-SWR) for hazardous waste disposal. Potential bidders may obtain bid documents by contacting the Solid Waste & Recycling Department, (503) 797-1650. **Sealed bids must be delivered to the Solid Waste & Recycling Department at Metro, 600 NE Grand, Portland, Oregon 97232-2736, to the attention of Ray Barker, no later than 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 6, 2003,** at which time they will be publicly opened and read in Room 275. A bid may not be submitted by Facsimile (FAX) transmittal

One or more supply contracts are hereby proposed for furnishing an estimated 10,000 reconditioned, 55-gallon steel drums (open-top) and 3,000 reconditioned, 55-gallon steel drums (tight-head) to be used for bulking and lab packing hazardous materials received, processed for disposal, and recycled through two permanent facilities and for miscellaneous satellite activities.

The contract or contracts contemplated are expected to commence June 1, 2003, and expire May 31, 2005.

Mistakes must be crossed out and corrections typewritten or written in ink adjacent thereto, and initialed in ink by the party signing the Bid, or his authorized representative.

Written amounts shall be shown in both words and figures. Words shall govern in cases of discrepancy between the amounts stated in words and the amounts stated in figures.

All bids must be on the form furnished by Metro or they may be rejected by Metro. Where plans and specifications are attached to the bid, they must be returned by the Bidder with the bid.
