II. SUMMONS

YOU ARE SUMMONED AND REQUIRED TO APPEAR at the hearing on the date, time and place indicated. The purpose of the hearing is to hear and consider evidence on the petition.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to be represented by an attorney at any hearings on the petition regarding the above-named child, to introduce evidence, to be heard on your own behalf, to examine witnesses, to receive a decision based solely on the evidence adduced at the hearing, and to an unbiased fact-finder.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT, if you are indigent and cannot afford an attorney, to have an attorney appointed for you by the court. In order to apply for a court-appointed attorney, contact Lewis County Juvenile Court by telephone at (360) 740-1178 or in person at the Lewis County Juvenile Courthouse at 1255 S.W. Pacific Avenue, Chehalis, Washington, 98532. An attorney can look at the social and legal files in this case, talk to the social worker, tell you about the law, help you understand your rights, and help you at trial.

YOU MAY BE responsible for the financial support of the above-named child if the child is placed in out-of-home care.

YOU SHOULD BE PRESENT AT THIS HEARING. If you do not come, the judge will not hear what you have to say. If you desire additional information about your child, you should contact the Department of Social and Health Services at (360) 807-7081.

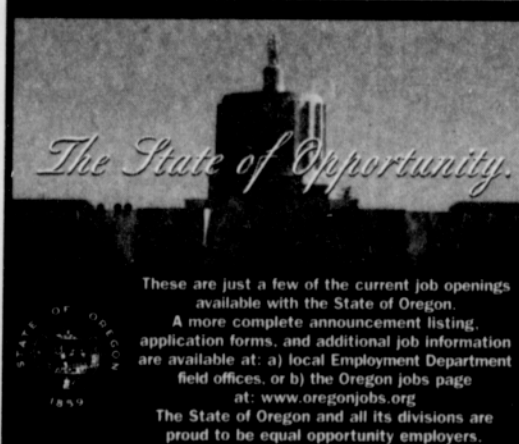

The 330xi sedan sports BMW classic looks of elegant and refined. My picture of BMW has been sporty, fast and great road handling with classy style. BMW has set the benchmark for the automakers industry with the sport sedans. Others envy the dynamics of this machines ability to corner, accelerate and stop swiftly. In 2003 BMW introduces the Onboard Navigation System to 3 series line and also added a center rear head restraint. The all wheel drive offers better traction and control in slippery conditions. The 330xi comes equipped with Hill Descent Control that is supposed to be helpful when descending a steep, slippery hill or driveway, however I did not get the chance to test it. The interior of the vehicle is appealing to the eye. The soft orange lighting on the instrument panel reduces night glare and seems to be easier on the eyes. The center control offers ease to the driver but one must get us to the window switch being located in the center, which requires the driver to take their eyes of the road. The 330xi is great for two adults but leaves little room for legs in the rear especially if the adults are average height. My experience driving the BMW 330xi was truly satisfying. I must warn others that stepping down on the accelerator at take off will throw one back against the seat. If you are one that enjoys the ultimate driving experience of speed, cornering and road handling the 330xi will offer the complete package.
