
Ja Rule **Wins Dispute**

Tiny label wins verdict against music giant

record company won a \$132 million TVT that included early Ja Rule verdict against industry heavyweight Island Def Jam Music Group and its top executive in a dispute over an unreleased record by rapper Ja Rule.

The verdict in the penalty phase of the trial provides roughly \$24 million in compensatory damages and \$108 million in punitive damages to New York-based TVT Records.
