Contractors and subcontractors must be licensed for asbestos abatement work if the project involves working with asbestos as set forth in ORS 468A.720.

No bid will be considered unless bidder is registered with the Construction Contractors Board as required by ORS 701.055 or licensed by the State Landscape Contractors Board as required by ORS 671.530.

No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a surety bond, certified check, or a cashiers check payable to Multnomah County for the amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the aggregate proposal. The successful bidder shall furnish a bond satisfactory to the board in the full amount of the contract.

The City of Portland proposes to amend its 2002-03 Consolidated Plan Action Plan in the following way:

- Strategic planning contract:** This contract for \$40,100 with Decisions, Decisions assists the City of Portland Bureau of Housing and Community Development (BHCD) with a community-based strategic planning process. To fund this, BHCD proposes to reallocate \$24,100 (CDBG) from Non-Profit Technical Assistance to Community-Based Organizations (leaving a balance of \$60,900), and to allocate \$16,000 from BHCD Administration for professional services (\$11,000 CDBG, \$5,000 HOME).
- Plaza de Cedro:** Adding funds to do improvements in the public right away for Plaza de Cedro project, \$40,000.
- JOIN:** Additional funds to JOIN for rehab of a non-profit facility, \$80,000. This was allocated out of the \$120,000 currently in the FY 02/03 Action Plan designated for public facilities.
- Carry Over Funds:** The City had \$500,000 carry-over from FY 01/02. These funds have been allocated to HOPE VI (\$425,000) and Jefferson High School Plaza and Pavilion construction (\$75,000).
- Spring 2003 Community Initiatives:** Community Initiative grants to serve low and moderate income residents have been awarded to the following public service (PS), public facility (PF) and rehabilitation (R) projects: **Better People**, a city-wide behavioral therapy group for youthful offenders (PS)(\$12,000). **Community Alliance of Tenants** a North and Outer SE Portland project using code enforcement to address poor housing conditions (PS) (\$12,000). **Education Action Team/Success By 6/United Way** a North Portland kindergarten transition project (PS)(\$11,224). **Growing Gardens** improvements to the North Portland St. Johns Woods community garden (PF) (\$5,000). **Human Solutions** a city-wide skill development project for Russian-speaking residents of H.S. housing facilities (PS) (\$10,267). **Humboldt Business District** an Inner N Portland "Back To School" block party (PS) (\$1,463). **Lutheran Community Services** city-wide ESL classes for immigrants and refugees (PS) (\$12,000). **Police Activities League** an Outer NE Portland bi-lingual summer program for youth in Cully neighborhood (PS) (\$10,940). **Portland Community Reinvestment Initiatives** a N and Inner NE Portland paint-a-thon to paint PCRI owned rental properties (R) (\$4,090). **Portland Youth Soccer Association** a city-wide Soccer Start Program for youth (PS) (\$11,800). **St. Johns in the 21st Century Target Area** Lombard Street, N Portland window arts project (PS) (\$3,500).

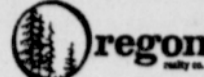

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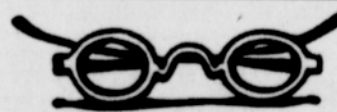
