Metro is soliciting bids for picnic shelters and restrooms site work at the Oxbow Regional Park located at 3010 SE Oxbow Parkway, Gresham, OR 97080. **Sealed Bids must be delivered to Metro, Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department, 600 N.E. Grand Avenue, Portland, OR 97232 to the attention of Glenn Taylor, Project Manager, no later than 11:00 am PST, on July 30, 2003.** The bids will be opened at 3:00 pm and publicly read aloud in Conference Room 270 located in the Metro Regional Center. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes and identified on the exterior with RFP #04-1080-PKS. All bids must be clearly and distinctly typed or written with ink or indelible pencil. All blank spaces must be completed. No erasures are permitted. Mistakes must be crossed out and corrections typewritten or written in ink adjacent thereto, and initialed in ink by the party signing the Bid, or his authorized representative.

Written amounts shall be shown in both words and figures. Words shall govern in cases of discrepancy between the amounts stated in words and the amounts stated in figures.

The Work contemplated consists of: demolition of two existing picnic shelters and three pit toilets; gravel pads for two pre-manufactured restrooms; parking lot modifications; 2300 SF of Eco pavers for handicap access travel areas; utilities connections for the restrooms including 2" diameter PVC water lines, electrical power conduits, 2" diameter PVC sewer force mains, septic & dosing tanks for each restroom and septic system pumps, filters, floats, and control panels; design/build site electrical including a radio controlled central monitored alarm system at the four unit restroom and one picnic shelter, installation of sewage pump control panels and conduit and wire to restroom panels and pumps and floats, restroom meter bases, and other conduit and wiring necessary for fully functioning electrical systems for the project and all necessary coordination with restroom manufacturer and local utility provider; and the construction of three 40' by 24' heavy timber picnic shelters with standing seam metal roofs, concrete floors and 8" CMU seating walls with manufactured river rock exterior veneer and pre-cast concrete seating caps.

The Economic Feasible Units (EFU's) identified for the MBE/WBE/ESB program by Metro for this project are demolition, excavation, utilities, electrical, concrete, heavy timber framing and metal roofing.
