**Gresham Inflow and Infiltration (I & I) Control Program
Implementation, CIP 300200
RFQ's due 3:00, July 31, 2003**

The City of Gresham intends to comprehensively review the current inflow and infiltration (I & I) Control Program, Capital Improvement Project 300200. The project involves evaluating the City's current I & I Control Program including data collection (collection system rainfall induced flow), hydraulic model (XP-SWMM™) calibration and capital improvement project identification. The City's anticipated budget for the project is approximately \$60,000 dollars.

The City of Gresham wishes to engage the services of a qualified equipment supplier to analyze the existing I & I control program and provide equipment installation and product services for data collection device deployment and management. The City's 2001 Wastewater (Collection System) Master Plan Update provides an updated and comprehensive I & I Plan. The City of Gresham would like to begin the project by October 2003. Supplier's qualifications include, but are not limited to, knowledge of wastewater collection flow monitoring technology, installation methods, and construction, operations and maintenance techniques.

The Suppliers responding to this RFQ shall furnish a written response setting forth the Suppliers specific experience in similar projects and their qualifications for providing the types of goods and services required. The written response shall be limited to: 1. A cover letter detailing your interest in this project (one page). 2. A brief statement that reflects your understanding of the project, your proposed approach to address key elements and your ability to provide a future RFP (two pages or less). 3. Key personnel available to be assigned to the project, their specific qualifications and experience on similar projects and the proportion of their time available for the project (no page limit). 4. Relevant specific client history and references are similar I & I program evaluation projects (no page limit).

The deadline for submitting a response to the RFQ is July 31, 2003, 3:00 pm, local time. Up to four of the most qualified candidates will be selected to prepare and submit comprehensive responses to a Request for Proposal. The RFQs will be evaluated by the City of Gresham on the following basis: Statement of Interest - 10%; Statement of Project Understanding/approach - 30%; Product compatibility - 30%; Client History/References - 30%.

The City of Gresham intends to vigorously pursue the selection of a Supplier and is intending to proceed with the following schedule: Receive and begin review of RFQs - July 31, 2003; Distribute RFP to short listed consultants - August 15, 2003; Receive and begin review of RFPs - September 5, 2003; Select Consultant - September 15, 2003; Contract Award - October 1, 2003; Complete Project - February 13, 2004.

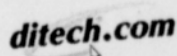
