thought would want to support her are trying to get rid of her."

The building's owner, Bill Leigh, said the eviction was "a very hard thing to do," claiming late rent payments "were getting out of hand" and were the only reason for the lease termination.

But Leigh said he does have several restaurants offering to move into the space at rent "substantially more" than Dean was paying.

Dean announced last year that Doris' was closing, then that her sons would operate it. She now says she hopes to re-establish the restaurant somewhere else.

Another developer, Jeanna Wooley, said local business and community leaders should have stepped in to help reconstitute the popular restaurant.

"Doris' is historic; it's been a bright light for this community," Wooley said.
