### Legendary 'King' Benny Carter Remembered

(AP)—Jazz great Benny Carter with or wrote music for nearly all of hardly ever looked back. He enjoyed whatever he was doing at the moment — composing or arranging, improvising on the alto sax or trumpet, leading a band or making opportunities for other black musicians.

"I don't look back at the good old days," Carter once said, "The good old days are here and now."

Carter died July 12 at age 95. In a career that spanned more Aug. 8, 1907, in New York.







