## Public Members Sought for Oregon's Commodity Commissions

A public member is being added to each of Oregon's 28 commodity commissions as set out in Senate Bill 854, which became law on July 22, 2003. Public members will be appointed to a term of not more than four years by the director of the Oregon Department of Agriculture, beginning as early as Sept. 30, 2003. Members of the public who are interested in the positive economic growth of one of the following commodities are encouraged to apply: Alpacore, Alfalfa Seed, Bartlett Pear, Beef Council, Blueberry, Clover Seed, Dairy Products, Dungeness Crab, Filbert (Hazelnut), Fine Fescue, Fryer, Grains, Highland, Bentgrass, Hop, Mint, Orchardgrass Seed Producers, Processed Vegetable, Raspberry and Blackberry, Potato, Ryegrass Growers Seed, Salmon, Sheep, Strawberry, Sweet Cherry, Tall Fescue, Trawl, Western Oregon Onion, and Wheat. Public member qualifications: U.S. citizen, bona fide Oregon resident, exhibit an active interest in the positive development and economic growth of the agriculture industry in Oregon, and not be associated with the production or handling of the commodity. Commodity commissions support Oregon's agriculture industries and enhance and preserve the economic interests of the state. They are funded through assessments. Commissions enhance the image of Oregon commodities in order to increase overall demand; educate citizens about the quality, care, and methods used in production; increase knowledge of their healthful qualities and dietetic values; and may support and engage in research. Each commission determines how to allocate its funds. Commissions meet at least twice a year and often as nine times a year. Some commissions reimburse for mileage and/or per diem.
