The exterior of the building will be constructed of structural brick, metal panels and glazing. The roof will be standing seam metal roof. New parking will be developed as part of the project north and east of the building. The parking area is designed as an auto court and will be constructed of permeable concrete pavers and asphalt. The parking area and pedestrian courtyard will be landscaped in a sustainable manner with native, low-maintenance plants.

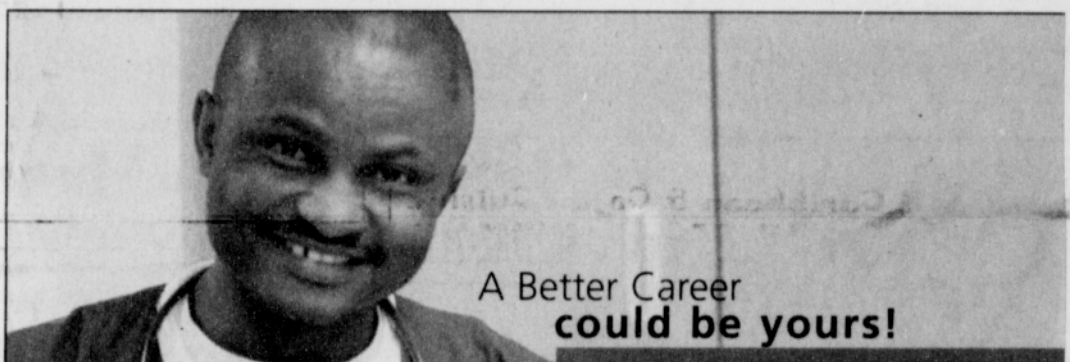

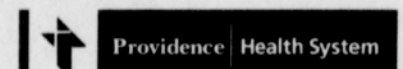
