



been convicted of a crime?'

Axhelm also addresses problems such as noise, yard clearing, adandoned vehicles and domestic disputes. In addition, he works with the Housing Authority of Portland and apartment complex managers to reduce noise complains and other

Other crime problems include thefts of personal possessions, bikes and cars. Often, the stolen goods are taken by transients.

"We can't solve drug abuse, homelessness and crime, but if we can make one street safer for the people that live on it, that's great," Axhelm said.

Northeast Neighborhood Office Deputy District Attorney Jim Hayden praised the SNO pro-

"I've always been a fan. You've got a group of police officers who work on investigating problems in the community. To have that resource available is very valuable to the Portland Police Bureau, the community and to me," Hayden said.

He said local residents can provide SNO officers the necessary information to issue arrest warrants to nuisance drug houses in their neighborhoods.

The warrants are served when enough evidence is accumulated.






