According to Multnomah County, a yes vote may cause property taxes to increase more than 3 percent.

This new government owned utility would have to pay more than \$1 billion to take over the poles, wires and substations of PGE and Pacific Power. Where would they get the money? From us—the ratepayers. We'd all pay for it through higher electric rates.

How high would electric rates go? No one knows.

However, the Oregon Office of Energy concluded that there is no way this new government owned utility can guarantee lower rates than what customers are already paying.

### Less Reliable Power


The boundary lines of this new government owned utility are poorly thought out and make no sense.
