The show features a three-story castle, the largest set ever for

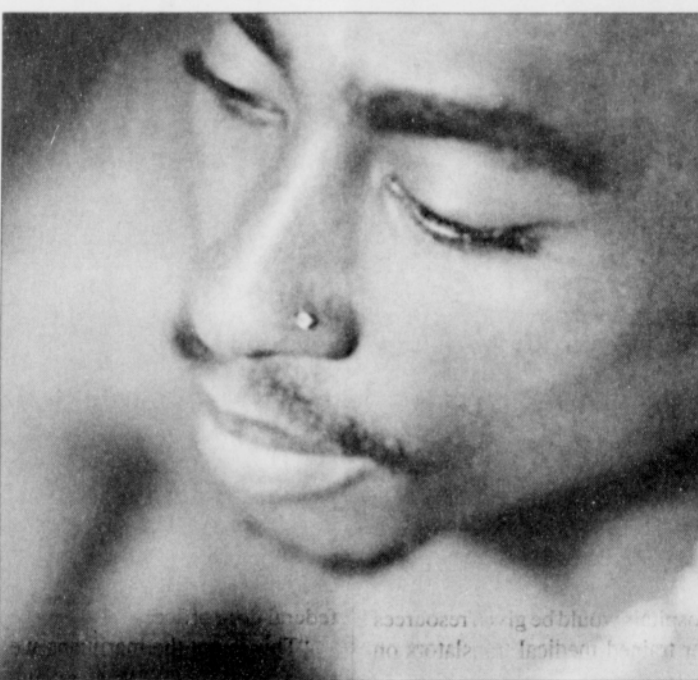

Film Celebrates Life of Tupac Shakur

Celebrating the life of Tupac Shakur, one of the top-selling hip-hop artists of all time, "Tupac Resurrection" is the only film about the global icon who died at the peak of career that was made in collaboration with his mother, former Black Panther Afeni Shaker.

The film is an intimate portrait of a young man who rose from a life of adversity into a global icon who touched millions of lives. It opens nationwide on Friday, Nov. 14.

Told entirely in his own words, "Tupac Resurrection" is a visually stunning, inspirational life story

featuring never-before-seen concert footage, private home movies and excerpts from Tupac's poetry and journals, all of which serve to create a very personal portrayal of a sensitive, passionate and often provocative artist.

In addition, the film features a soundtrack of Shakur's best-selling music, as well as all new music by Biggie Smalls, Eminem, 50 Cent and Shakur himself, who currently ranks among the top 40 best-selling artists of all time, with more than 33.5 million records sold to date.

Firehouse Hosts Native American Poet

Native American poet and visual artist Liz Woody will open this season's Origins Lecture Series at the Interstate Firehouse Cultural Center on north Interstate Avenue on Wednesday, Nov. 12 at 7 pm.

Woody has published poetry, short fiction, essays and visual works. She is a recipient of the William Stafford Memorial Award for Poetry from the Pacific Northwest Bookseller's Association and a finalist in the poetry category for the Oregon Book Awards.

Origins is IFCC's annual lecture series, "a

conversation between artists and audience" bringing noted artists, writers and performers to speak their views on the influence of cultural identity on the creative process. The series is intended to encourage and increase cultural awareness and to bridge the gaps that often impede the pursuit of common goals among diverse populations.
