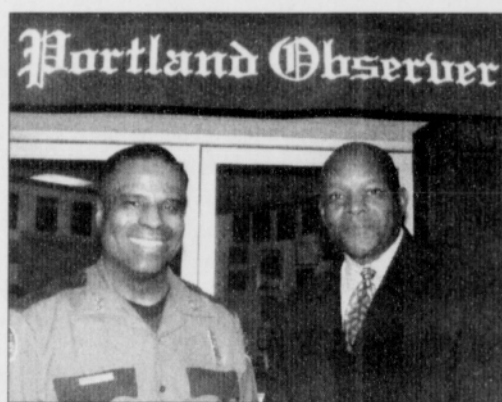
## Meek Packs Up for Good
