Shortly thereafter, bids will be opened and publicly read. **The First-Tier Subcontractor List, HAP-421, must be received by 4:00 p.m. the same day.** No bidder may withdraw their bid after the hour set for opening until after lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.

The basic work consists of replacing the existing roofing with new composition shingles or metal roofing, new fascia boards, gutter and downspouts, metal flashing, roof vents, and rough carpentry. This is a unit price contract for a 1-year renewal option.

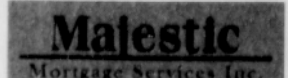
