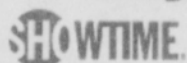

## The Art of Recycling

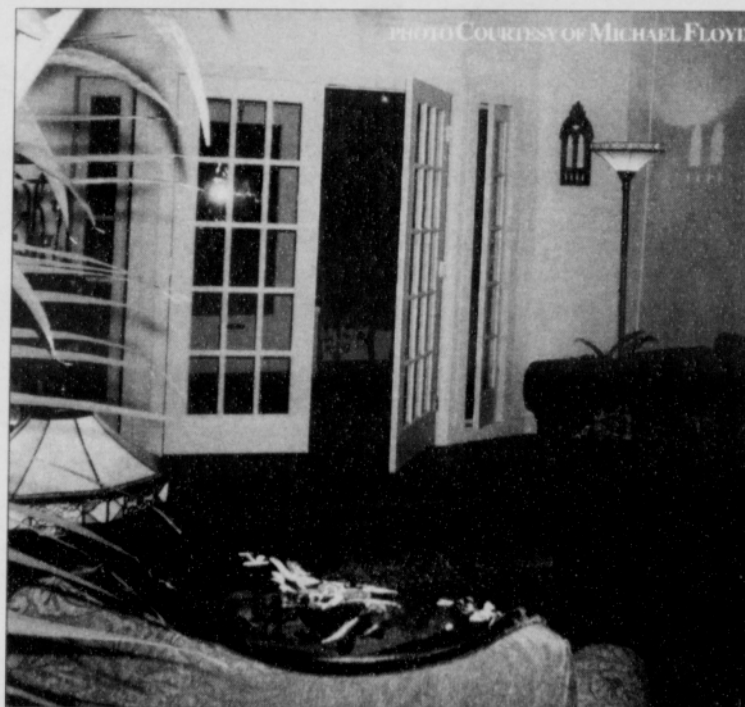
