Card Set for Championship Fights

Back to back boxing events scheduled at Chinook Winds

Professional boxing returns to Oregon with twice the tenacity at Chinook Winds Casino and Convention Center in Lincoln City.

Commotion at the Ocean V - Back to Back brings two top rank boxing events on two consecutive nights, Thursday, June 3 and Friday, June 4. Each will be televised live on Showtime and FOX Sports Net networks.

Each night will include six boxing bouts. Two championship titles will be on the line on June 3 and still another on June 4.

The action starts on June 3, with featherweight sensation Robert "The Ghost" Guerrero (12-0-1, 5 KO's) pitted against former world

champion Enrique Sanchez (30-2-4, 21 KO's) for the IBA Featherweight Championship. Ranked by USA Today as one of the top prospects to watch in 2004, Guerrero most recently KO'd former world champion Juan "Polo" Perez in round two this past April 24.

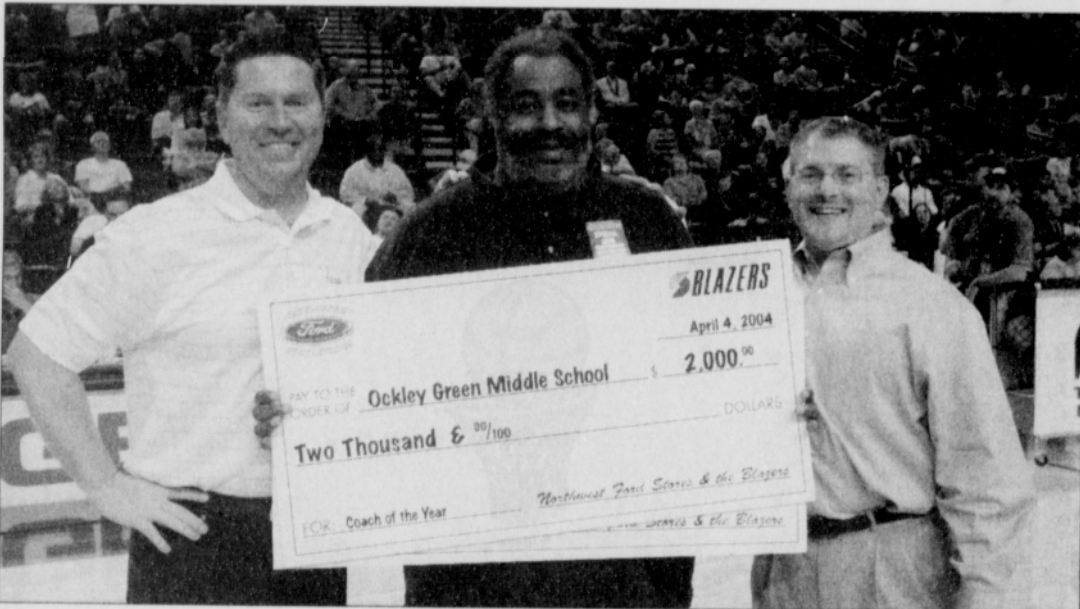
In the second title fight that evening, Jorge Martinez (11-1-1, 2 KO's) locks horns with Juan Carlos Ramirez (33-5, 13 KO's) competing for the NABF Featherweight Championship. Martinez has won nine consecutive fights including the Hispanic World Boxing Association's 130-pound belt with TKO over Victor Dominguez.

On June 4, a NABF Junior Middleweight Championship featuring two-time middleweight world champion Keith Holmes (39-3, 25 KO's) combating Rodney Jones (33-3, 22 KO's). Holmes is a two-time former world champion at 160 pounds. He moved to the 154-pound weight class in 2003 and promptly scored three impressive victories. He is rated eighth in the world by the WBO.

Jones, currently rated fifth in the world by the WBO, is riding a nine fight winning streak, all knockouts.

Bryant Pleas Not Guilty

(AP)— Nearly 11 months after his arrest, NBA star Kobe Bryant pleaded not guilty Tuesday in Eagle, Colo. to a rape charge that could land him in prison for life.

Standing impassively before state District Judge Terry Ruckriegle, Bryant said only four words during his brief arraignment.

"Yes sir," he said, bending slightly to speak into a microphone when asked if he understood the charge and potential penalty. Asked for his plea, he answered "not guilty" and sat down shortly afterward.

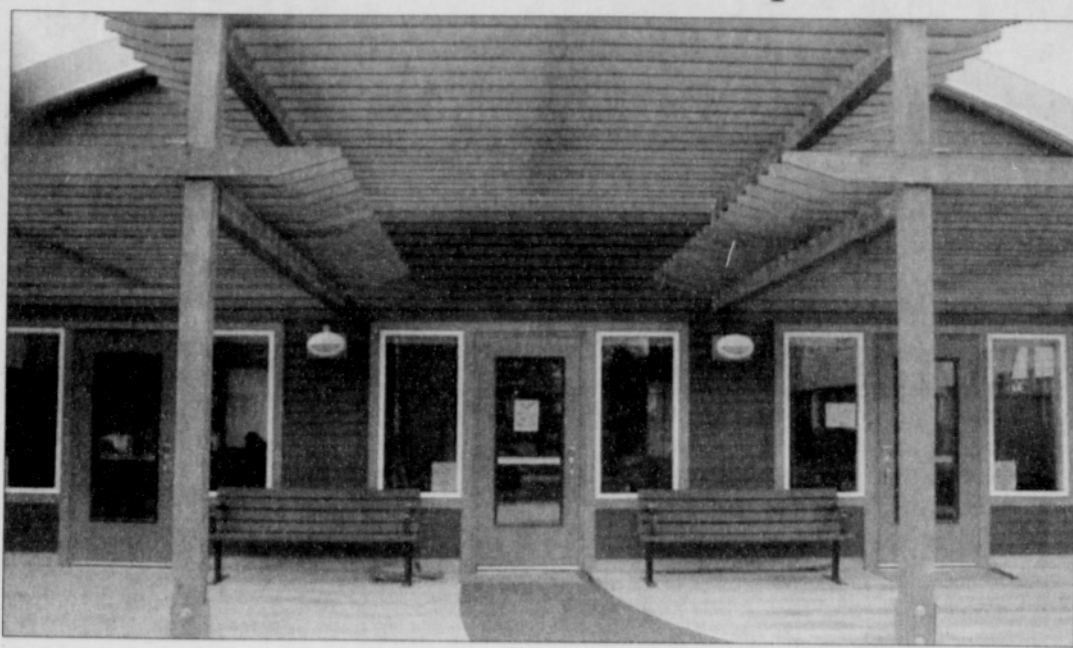

Park Terrace Shines with Improvements

The remodeling by Portland Community Reinvestment Initiatives, Inc. (PCRI) won an Oregon Housing and Community Services award for preserving long-term affordable housing for area residents.

old residents with new ones, tied in part to new public investment in housing stocks.

A number of new and revamped owner-occupied homes brought positive changes to the area, but many existing area residents were unable to see the benefits of these changes because they were forced out by skyrocketing housing costs.

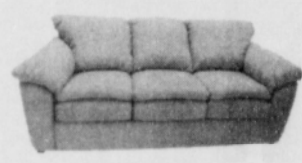
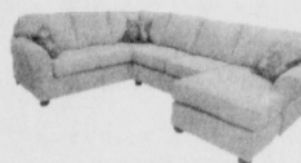
"The preservation of Park Terrace by PCRI ensures that Park Terrace residents can afford to stay and enjoy the benefits that new public investment and private investment bring to their neighborhood," said Ian Slingerland, executive director of the Community Alliance of tenants.

PCRI had a primary goal of preserving the long-standing affordable housing project and avoiding displacement of the residents, 15

percent of whom have lived at Park Terrace for 15 years or more. Many of the residents are 55 years of age or older, living on a fixed income with very little physical or economic ability to respond to the rising housing market, according to PCRI insiders.

The entire renovation, which involved four years of negotiations, rehabilitation and new construction, was completed on schedule and under budget.

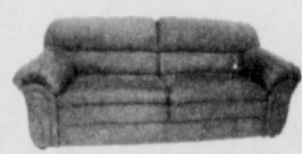
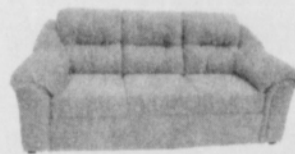
