Bidder's compliance to ORS 279.027 regarding submission of the First-Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Form is required. Disclosure forms are provided within the bid documents and must be submitted in a sealed envelope at the location specified in this Invitation to Bid on the bid closing date and within two (2) City business hours after the bid closing time.

WORK DESCRIPTION: The work generally includes construction of grading, landscaping, walkway improvement, concrete court, site furnishing, playground installation and miscellaneous incidentals for a complete and functional facility, pursuant to Contract Documents. The estimate of construction costs if \$140,000. The Project shall be completed in 90 days following issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to the bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON THORP PARK DEVELOPMENT- BID#045034" and show the name and business address of the bidder.

No bid, exceeding \$2,000 will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains statement by bidder (by signing his proposal) that the provisions of the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a) shall be complied with. Every contractor ontractor is required to post the applicable prevailing wage rates in a conspicuous and accessible place in or about the worksite for the duration of the job. Contractors and subcontractors who intentionally fail to post the PWR can be made ineligible to receive any public works contract for up to three years.


