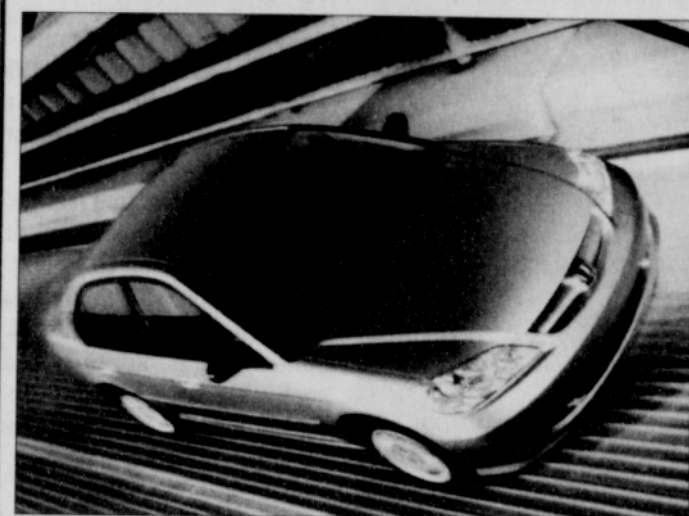

The 2004 Honda Civic EX is still at the top of America's best selling compacts. This automobile is reliable, economical and comfortable; a vehicle that can be sold to a diverse consumer. It rolls in this year with a new body styling with reshaped front and rear bumpers, new hood, headlights, and front grille. The wedge-shaped contour remains unchanged, which, in my opinion, is a benefit for Honda because it still has a distinguished style that notes it as a Honda.

Civic EX models get more power from a 127-horsepower VTEC version of the 1.7-liter engine. The vehicle has just the right amount of power for the young and old. It has a comfortable feel on the road that hugs the corners.

The Civic is a vehicle that is easy to drive with great visibility for the driver. The interior is roomy for smaller passengers, though for larger passengers it lacks comfort and room. The center console is user-friendly so that it does not distract from the driver's attention. EX also gets 15-inch aluminum wheels, body-colored power mirrors, upgraded audio with six speakers and a tilt-and-slide glass sunroof.

The Civic is noted for being sporty and economical. With the price of gas today it will be easy on the pocket book. The safety of the vehicle has proven to be outstanding. In my opinion it rates on the top of the charts.

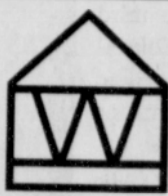
