The bids will be publicly opened at that date, immediately after the 4:00 p.m. deadline in the **Oregon Trail Room**.

The character of the work **generally includes the installation of approximately 3397 linear feet of 8" diameter PVC sewer main, 500 linear feet of 15" diameter PVC sewer main, 771 linear feet of 8" diameter HDPE sewer main, 1886 linear feet of 12" diameter HDPE sewer main, 798 linear feet of 15" diameter HDPE sewer main. The contemplated work is located along existing right of ways. The work is located in an area bounded by NE 3rd St. to the North, SW Roberts Ave. to the West, SE 9th St. to the South, and SE Juniper Ave. to the East. Work includes Pipe bursting, Open cut trenching, connections to existing sewer lines, abandoning the existing sewer lines.** The major quantities involved are:
