Area residents are invited to hear a motivational speaker who coaches women to give "birth" to their dreams utilizing the process of birthing.

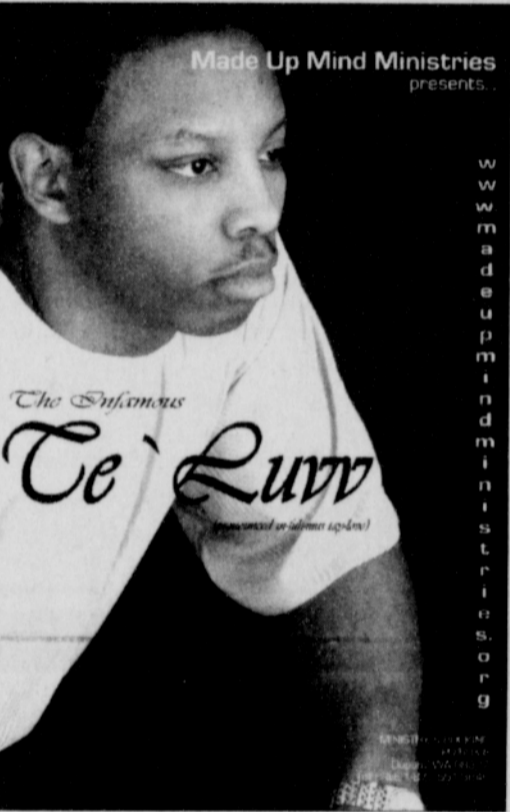
