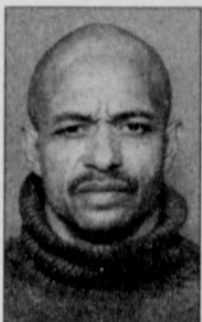
CRIME STOPPERS

Wanted Fraud Suspect Washington resident may be hiding out in Portland

Portland Metro Crime Stoppers, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers of Puget Sound, needs your help in finding Warren Eric Armstead, a wanted man.

Snohomish County, Washington, has a no bail warrant for the arrest Armstead, 48, on charges of escape, I.D. theft, and drug possession. He has a home and family in Shoreline, WA. He travels the Interstate 5 corridor, and may be hiding out in the Portland metro area.

Armstead steals identification and identification information and then creates or alters checks. He cashes the fraudulent checks and gets away with the money. He is involved in credit card fraud as well.

Armstead is about 5 feet 8 inches tall, 165 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes. He wears his hair short, or even shaved. He has freckles on his face. He has tattoos on both arms. He uses the aliases of George Williams, Warren Jones, and Warren Williams.

Risky Behavior in Prison

A study identifying risky behavior that prison inmates engage in has revealed that certain behaviors are responsible for the spread of communicable diseases after the inmates are released. The study, commissioned by the Oregon Department of Corrections, showed that the frequency of high-risk behaviors for male inmates is greatest for tattoos, followed by sexual activity, body piercing and intravenous drug use. For female inmates, the most common high-risk behaviors, in order, include sexual activity, tattooing, body piercing and intravenous drug usage.

The study, determining the prevalence of risky behavior in prison, in part, was built on discussions with the Cascade Aids Project

and others concerned about prisoners and public health. The survey showed that high-risk behaviors are less prevalent in Oregon's prisons than most national estimates.

"We recognize the role prisons potentially have in the spread of contagious diseases," said Corrections Director Max Williams.

Most prisoners will eventually return to their communities. In Oregon, about half of the prison population will be released within 24 months, and approximately 95 percent will eventually be released. "If diseases are transmitted among prisoners through high-risk behaviors, it is logical that reducing these behaviors would help limit the spread of disease in prison and our communities upon release," Williams said.

Woman Charged in Traffic Death

Clyde L. Karr was struck and killed in a hit and run accident on Aug. 4, at about 11:15 a.m., at the intersection of Southeast Powell Boulevard and 151st Avenue. Karr was 62 and legally blind.

Misty Walton, 26, the driver of the pickup truck that struck Karr, was arrested after leaving the scene of the accident.

A witness followed her providing updates to police on a cell phone. The suspect pulled into a parking lot near Southeast 148th Avenue and Southeast Division Street where police found her and took her into custody.

Body at Park Identified

When Portland Police officers responded to a call of "shots fired" in Kenilworth Park in southeast Portland at approximately 1:30 a.m. on Aug. 4, they found the body of 26-year-old Trevor John Rowe. His death was ruled a homicide after an autopsy revealed that Rowe died of
