## Lewis, Bono Earn Freedom Awards

National Civil Rights Museum to bestow honors

(AP) — Rep. John Lewis, D-Ga., and entertainer Bono were named recipients last Thursday of the National Civil Rights Museum's annual Freedom Awards.

The museum on the site of Martin Luther King Jr.'s murder in Memphis, Tenn. gives two Free-

dom Awards annually to recipients who have worked to advance civil rights.

Past recipients include civil

rights pioneer Rosa Parks, former South African President Nelson Mandela and former President Carter.

Lewis "has maintained an unflinching, principled commitment to the ideals of equality and justice," the museum said in making the announcements.

Lewis will receive the museum's "national award" at a banquet in Memphis on Oct. 18. At that ceremony, U2 frontman

Bono will get the museum's "international award."

Bono, a native of Ireland who rose to fame as singer with the rock group U2, has championed social justice with his music and activism, the museum said.

The main section of the museum is built around the former Lorraine Motel, where King was killed by a sniper April 4, 1968, as he stood on a second-floor balcony.

King's convicted killer, James Earl Ray, died in prison in 1998.

## Gore Cited on Oregon Coast

(AP) — Former Vice President Al Gore was cited for speeding as he drove a rented car to visit family on the Oregon coast, authorities said.

Gore, who was alone, was issued a \$141 ticket for driving 75 miles per hour on Highway 26 in the northwest corner of the state, police said. The speed limit is 55.

Gore was issued the ticket on Aug. 3 at 12:37 p.m., said Lt.

Dale Rutledge, spokesman for the Oregon State Police.

The trooper who stopped Gore did not recognize him until he furnished his license, Sgt. Andrew Merila told KATU-TV.

The trooper said Gore, who carried Oregon when he ran for president in 2000, was polite throughout the encounter.

Gore has until December to decide whether to fight the ticket.

## Gang Shooting Arrests

A Multnomah County Grand Jury has indicted Kentrell A. Tillman, 20, Christopher J. Rainier, 21 and Mario L. Neal, 19 on two counts of attempted aggravated murder and other charges.

The indictment follows the July 29 gang-related shooting of Joseph J. Mills, 21, and Anthony D. Bell, 17, near the intersection of North Haight Avenue and North Failing Street. The victims arrived at Emanuel Hospital with gunshot wounds to the lower back area.

The Gang Enforcement Team and The Youth Gun Anti-Violence Task Force initiated an investigation and arrested all three suspects.
