Guilty Plea in Family Murder
North Portland man escapes death penalty

(AP)—Edward Morris, the north Portland man accused of killing his pregnant wife and their three children, will serve four consecutive life sentences without parole after agreeing Monday to plead guilty to the murders.

Morris, 39, avoided a possible death sentence as a part of the plea worked out between his lawyers and prosecutors in Tillamook County. The bodies of Renee Morris and her three children were found in a remote area of the Tillamook State Forest in December 2002.

A formal plea and sentencing is scheduled for Nov. 15. Morris has agreed not to appeal.

After his arrest in January 2003, detectives said Morris told them he had been planning the murders for about three weeks.

Morris said he shot his 31-year-

old wife and two sons—ages 4 and 10—in a car along Highway 6 near the Oregon state prison camp in the Tillamook State Forest, according to court documents.

He said he then killed his 8-year-old daughter and left the four bodies alongside a logging road in the forest, where they were found. An autopsy showed the daughter had been stabbed at least 18 times.

One body was found by elk hunters. The others were found nearby by authorities.

Morris then went on the run for a few weeks to Nevada and Arizona before he was finally arrested Jan. 4 in Baker City.

False Arrest Leads to Investigation

Feds say Patriot Act by have been misused

(AP)—The Justice Department's watchdog office has opened an investigation into the arrest of a Muslim lawyer from Portland that was based on what turned out to be faulty FBI analysis of a fingerprint linked to the deadly terrorist attack in Spain last March.

Glenn A. Fine, the department's inspector general, said the antiter-

rorism Patriot Act may have been improperly used in the arrest of attorney Brandon Mayfield.

Mayfield, a Muslim convert, was arrested May 6 on a material witness warrant after an FBI analysis concluded he was a match for a fingerprint found on a bag containing detonators like those used in the attacks on trains in Madrid that killed nearly 200 people and wounded 2,000.

A few weeks later, Mayfield was released after the FBI admitted it had made a mistake and that the fingerprint did not match

Mayfield's.

The inspector general's investigation was disclosed in a twice-a-year report to Congress on potential civil rights and civil liberties abuses by Justice Department officials.

The Mayfield investigation is focusing on how the fingerprint error was made and also on a complaint by Mayfield that the "FBI inappropriately conducted a surreptitious search of his home ... potentially motivated by his Muslim faith and ties to the Muslim community," according to Fine's report.

Keep Police Accountable

Thief Wanted for Check Scams

Portland Police, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers is asking for the public's help in finding 38-year-old Herbert Wayne Marambe.

Police said Marambe is known to write fraudulent cashiers checks that look real, but are worthless when victims try to cash them at a bank. He is accused of disappearing after obtaining jewelry, electronic equipment and even vehicles with the checks.

Authorities said Marambe is well dressed and can be quite personable and trustworthy. He has provided real identification and has allowed himself to be photographed. He may even spend a considerable amount of

time with them gaining their favor. All of this is part of his elaborate scam which is completed when he exchanges the item of value for the worthless check.

Marambe is a black male, about 5 feet 10 inches tall and 220 pounds. He has had addresses in Southeast Portland. Detectives don't know where he is now, but suspect he is still in the metro area and may still be committing his brand of theft.
