Young Woman Killed Sunday

A 19-year-old woman was killed Sunday after being shot in the vicinity of North Blandena Street and Michigan Avenue.

Police responded to a shots fired call at 12:45 a.m. and found the victim, Jacqueline S. Marcell, behind the wheel of a vehicle parked at North Mississippi Avenue and Skidmore Street. She was transported to the hospital and died several hours later.

An autopsy determined Marcell died from a gunshot wound. Detectives are attempting to determine if her death is connected to other shots fired calls received from the same general area.

Detectives believe that the shooting may be related to gang activity, though there is no information indicating that Marcell was involved with gangs. Detectives are seeking witnesses who may have seen anyone in the area prior to the shooting.

Young Man Wanted in Murder Case

The Portland Police Bureau and Crime Stoppers need your help in finding a wanted man. Jerry Deshawn Lawrence, 17, has been indicted for murder and robbery in the shooting death of a man in southeast Portland.

On Aug. 4, 22-year-old Trevor Rowe was shot and killed in Kenilworth Park, near the 3200 block of Southeast Holgate Boulevard. George Bingham III, 16, was ar-

rested in connection with this incident in August. Detectives said Lawrence was known to hang around Kenilworth Park and had lived in southeast

Portland. He may still be in the area, but police think it is possible he has fled to avoid capture. Detectives would like to talk with anyone who has information about this case or who has seen or spoken with Lawrence recently.

Lawrence is described as a black male, about 6 feet 1 and weighs about 160 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes. He has cut his hair very short. Crime Stoppers is offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information, reported to Crime Stoppers, that leads to the identification and arrest of any suspect associated with this, or any unsolved felony, and you may remain anonymous. 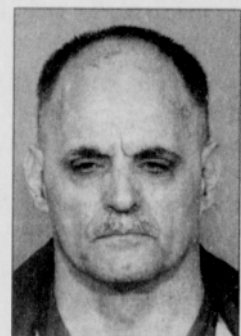
Caretaker Accused of Abuse

Police seek more victims

Detectives arrested 57-year-old Michael Anthony Bruno on criminal mistreatment and aggravated theft in connection with elder abuse.

Multnomah County Aging Services representatives discovered a 90-year-old woman with a hip fracture lying on a bare mattress encrusted with fecal material and soaked in urine. She had developed serious medical conditions because of her living conditions and was transported to an area hospital.

During the investigation, detectives learned that Bruno had befriended the victim several years

ago, after the death of her husband. Bruno allegedly convinced her to allow him to have power of attorney over her finances and later convinced her that she did not need medical treatment for her injuries. Bruno told investigators

that he frequently dates elderly women, including women in their 90s, leading investigators to believe that there may be additional victims.

Louisville Cop Acquitted in Shooting

Friends say 'no justice'

(AP) — Family and friends of a 19-year-old black man killed by a white police detective were angered by the officer's partial acquittal in the case.

Former detective McKenzie Mattingly was acquitted Wednesday of murder, manslaughter and reckless homicide charges in the Jan. 3 shooting of 19-year-old Michael Newby, who was shot three times in the back during an undercover drug buy.

"Three bullets in the back ain't justice," Leroy Nobles, a former friend of Newby, said after the verdict was read Wednesday night.

Outside the courthouse, Newby's stepfather, Jerry Bougness, said: "There are murderers out here."

The panel of 10 white and two black jurors returned a partial verdict after more than eight hours of deliberations. The judge declared a mistrial on a separate charge of wanton endangerment after the jury was unable to agree on that count.
