## Home to Gospel

### Holiday concert to benefit cancer fight

The fight against breast cancer will win support during the mix-and-mingle holiday performance, "Going Home to Gospel," featuring gifted singer and entertainer Patrick Minner, the Minner Trio and jazz favorite Janice Scroggins.

Some of the proceeds from the local event will be donated to Hearts of Hope, a breast cancer care program that offers free care to patients and focuses on all aspects of health and wellness.

A native Portlander, Minner said, "cancer is currently and has in the past impacted my family and I would like to use what voice I have to encourage education."

Breast cancer occurrences and fatalities differ between racial and ethnic groups in the United States. According to statistics from 2003, breast cancer strikes about 100 African-American females per 100,000 women. The rate is slightly higher for Caucasian women while less for Asians, Latinas and Native-American women.

Breast cancer is also the leading cause of cancer deaths for American women ages 20 to 39 and 40 to 59, surpassing lung cancer death

for women aged 60 and older. Each year about 39,000 women and 400 men die from the disease.
