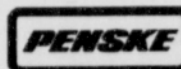

The City of Portland proposes to amend its Consolidated Plan 2000-2005 and 2004-2005 Action Plan as follows:

- A. Amend the Consolidated Plan 2000-2005 and the Action Plan 2004-2005 to include the Fall 2004 Community Initiatives. Community Initiative grants to serve low and moderate income residents have been awarded to the following public service (PS), public facility (PF), planning (P) and economic development (ED) projects; **BEACH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** To provide new playground equipment for the Inner N/NE school (\$8,579) (PF); **CHESS FOR SUCCESS** To expand after-school chess program in North Portland. (\$12,000) (PS); **CHILDREN'S JUSTICE ALLIANCE** To provide for the Parent/Child Literacy Connection program to improve literacy skills and establish a culture of reading in North Portland. (\$12,000) (PS); **COMMUNITY CYCLING CENTER** To support the Bike Mechanic Apprenticeship Program for Inner N/NE Portland. (\$12,000) (PS); **COMMUNITY OF WRITERS** To support the city-wide Wordstock Book Fair School Outreach Project, an in-school writing program. (\$12,000) (PS); **HUMAN SOLUTIONS** To support the CRAFT Program that promotes self-sufficiency for victims of domestic violence in East/Outer SE Portland. (\$12,000) (PS); **IMMIGRANT & REFUGEE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION (IRCO)** To support the financial and economic education for immigrants city-wide. (\$11,621) (PS) **INCIGHT COMPANY**. To support the city-wide Empowerment Skills Program. (\$12,000) (PS); **OREGON MICROENTERPRISE NETWORK** To encourage the city-wide training and tradeshow participation for low income micro-entrepreneurs. (\$ 6,000) (ED).
- B. Amend the Action Plan FY 2004-2005 to reflect that the City of Portland was awarded a Lead Grant renewal in the amount of \$3,000,000. The funds will be contracted to the Portland Development Commission for lead hazard reduction in Multnomah County, Clackamas County, Washington County, and Clark County, Washington.
- C. Amend the Action Plan FY 2004-2005 to add new activity: Contract with Street Roots in the amount of \$20,000 (CDBG). The funding will be used to rehab new office space large enough to allow Street Roots, a community newspaper covering issues concerning homelessness, to hire one additional worker at a living wage job. Benefit: job creation.
