Metro Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department hereby requests sealed bids for approximately 233,000 square feet of one and one-half (1-1/2") inch asphalt concrete paving overlay and other pertinent items at the following locations: Oxbow Regional Park (5,800 LF at 19 feet average width plus boat launch access road and parking area) located at 3010 SE Oxbow Parkway in Gresham, Oregon; Lone Fir Cemetery (5,795 LF varying in width from 11 to 18 feet) located at SE 21st and SE Morrison Street in Portland, OR; and Glendoveer Golf Course Trail Head Parking Lot (14,100 square feet.) located at NE 148th and NE Halsey Street in Portland, OR.
