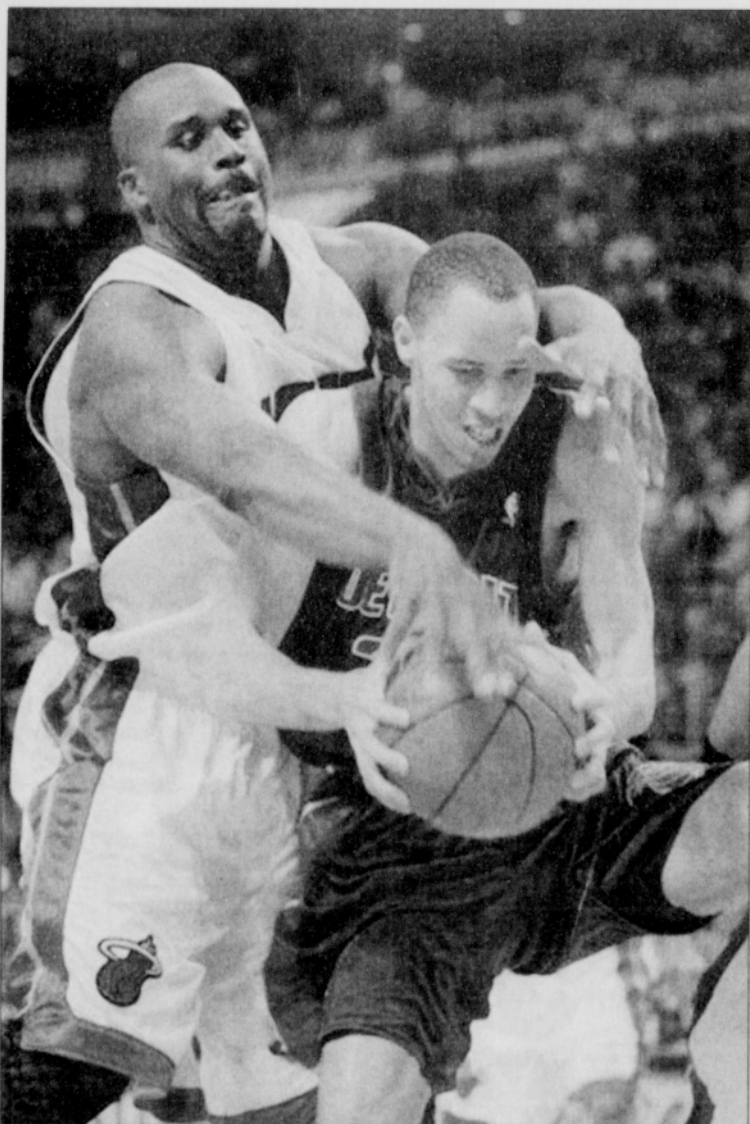
president of the South African Council Churches, and Methodist Bishop of the Johannesburg/Sowe area for 13 years.

Detroit Muscles Game One



(AP) — Rasheed Wallace shot 4-for-5 from 3-point range and scored 20 points, Chauncey Billups had eight of his 18 points in the fourth quarter, and Ben Wallace had 13 points and 13 rebounds as the Detroit Pistons beat the Miami Heat 90-81 in Game 1 of the Eastern Conference finals Monday night.

Shaquille O'Neal was back and productive, often barreling his way past the Pistons. Yet, the end result almost seemed to mirror last year's NBA Finals. O'Neal did his thing, and it ultimately didn't matter.

"It's a big win," Billups said. "Not having home-court advantage sometimes is an advantage for us because we play with that chip on our shoulder from Game 1. ... We snuck one out here, snuck one away."

O'Neal - who's still bothered by a bruised thigh - had 20 points in 33 minutes on 9-of-14 shooting.

Cheeks Gets Wish

(AP) — Former Portland Trail Blazer Coach Maurice Cheeks got his dream job Monday as coach of the Philadelphia 76ers.

Cheeks was hired on the same day Philadelphia Coach Jim O'Brien was fired.

O'Brien, a Philadelphia native who played for Saint Joseph's, went 49-33 in his only season and the Sixers were eliminated in the first round of the playoffs.

Cheeks was one of the most popular 76ers from 1978-89 and played on Philadelphia's last championship team, in 1983.

Cheeks will be Philadelphia's fourth coach since Larry Brown resigned and left for Detroit following the 2002-3 season. Randy Ayers was fired 52 games into the 2003-4 season and replaced by Chris Ford.
