OSU Falls in College World Series

(AP) — Oregon State had their chance in the College World Series, but Baylor took Monday with a 4-3 victory in 10 innings over the Beavers.

Mike Pankratz, batting .193, blooped an RBI single over first baseman Andy Jenkins and just out of the reach of second baseman Chris Kunda, ending the Oregon State's first appearance in the CWS since 1952.

Jeff Mandel (4-0) got the win for Baylor after holding Oregon State (46-12) to one hit in 4 2-3 innings of relief.

The Beavers had a 3-1 loss to Purdue on Sunday in the first game of the double-elimination tournament.

(AP) — When the final putt dropped at Pinehurst, N.C., Michael Campbell pulled the lid of his cap down across his face and let the moment linger.

He had taken on Tiger and won. He had played Pinehurst to a push. He had finished four days in brutal conditions and come out not only unscathed, but ahead. A winner. The U.S. Open champion.

Campbell, the New Zealander who a few years ago considered

giving up the game and selling golf balls, took control Sunday after a stunning collapse by Retief Goosen. Then he held off none other than Tiger Woods to become the latest surprise winner of a major championship.

He shot 1-under-par 69 to finish the tournament at par, an even draw with the withering course and two strokes ahead of Woods, who also closed with a 69.

court. Kids have a tendency when they're tired to bring out their negative side," Penn said. "Basketball is about being on the spot. We talk to them openly."

The lessons make for a smoother transition when the kids go back to school in the fall.

"There's focus and listening when these kids come out here," Penn said. "They remember these things when they go back to school. The same things that go in hand with teaching go into basketball."

Johnny Gage, a volunteer with the Oregon Action Project, said the atmosphere of the clinics is respectful.

"The dynamics are different. Basketball is used to encourage other things," Gage said. "It gives them a chance to experience some of the things we want kids to learn to get them to where they're healthy and have a realistic view on life. If you have an impact on these kids now, you'll have a different kid at 16. You'll see a different community."

The All-American Youth Basketball Clinic will be held through Aug. 5 for boys and girls, ages 7 to 11 at Irving Park on Northeast Seventh Avenue and Fremont Street. Admission is only \$8 per week, including a free lunch.

2005 BMW 645Ci

Vehicle tested information: Price: \$76,020; Engine: 4.4 liter DOHC 32-valve (4 cam) V-8; Transmission: Six speed manual.

The BMW 645Ci delivers stellar performance, brilliant handling, and that arrow-like stability that marks this marquee. The 6 Series is a true grand touring car, unique in the BMW line-up. And it comes in coupe and convertible styles. The 645Ci Coupe qualifies as an ultimate driving machine yet can be driven all day in perfect comfort.

The BMW 645Ci Coupe (\$69,900) and 645Ci Convertible (\$76,900) are nearly identical in temperament and equipment. Leather upholstery, a choice of rich interior trim, and a long list of luxury features are standard, including a sports suspension, 18-inch wheels, xenon adaptive headlamps, and park assist.

A plush cockpit features articulated bucket seats and trimmings in leathers and hardwoods. There are luxurious appointments and power controls with memory settings, plus electronic tools like BMW's computerized iDrive controller. The coupe carries a vast panorama glass moon roof but the convertible gets a one-button automatic mechanism to fold the lid into a slot behind the cabin and seal it with a rigid metal tonneau cover. The one thing that I found would need to be corrected is the legroom for the rear passengers, because if someone taller is sitting up front there is not legroom for rear passengers.

BMW's 4.4-liter V8 powers the 645Ci models, delivering 325 horsepower to the rear wheels. A choice of transmissions includes a six-speed manual gearbox (standard), a six-speed automatic with Steptronic (a no-cost option), and a six-speed sequential manual gearbox (\$1,300).

Options included on this vehicle were the Cold Weather Package (\$750) which includes heated front seats, steering wheel and ski bag; Premium Sound Package: Logic 7 audio system, 6-disc CD changer; and the Sports Package with active steering, shadowline exterior trim, 19" alloy wheels and performance run-flat tires.
