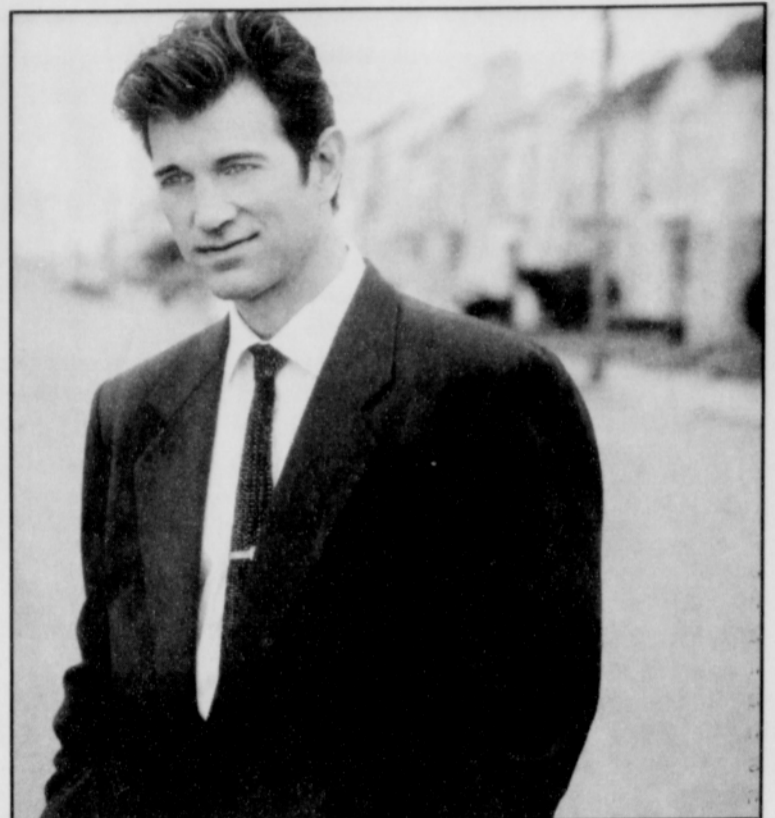
pivotal influence for many of today's female singer/songwriters.
