## Gospel Celebrated at 'Midnight Prayze'

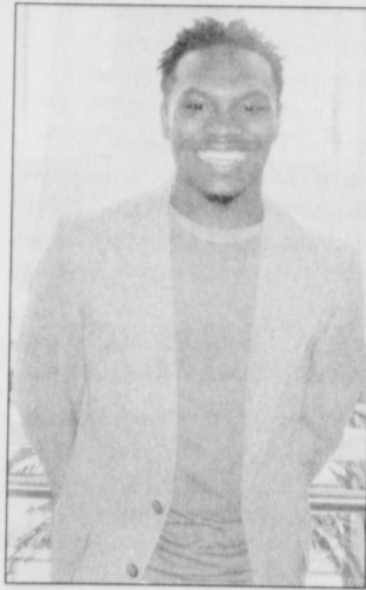
Late night music performance features top acts

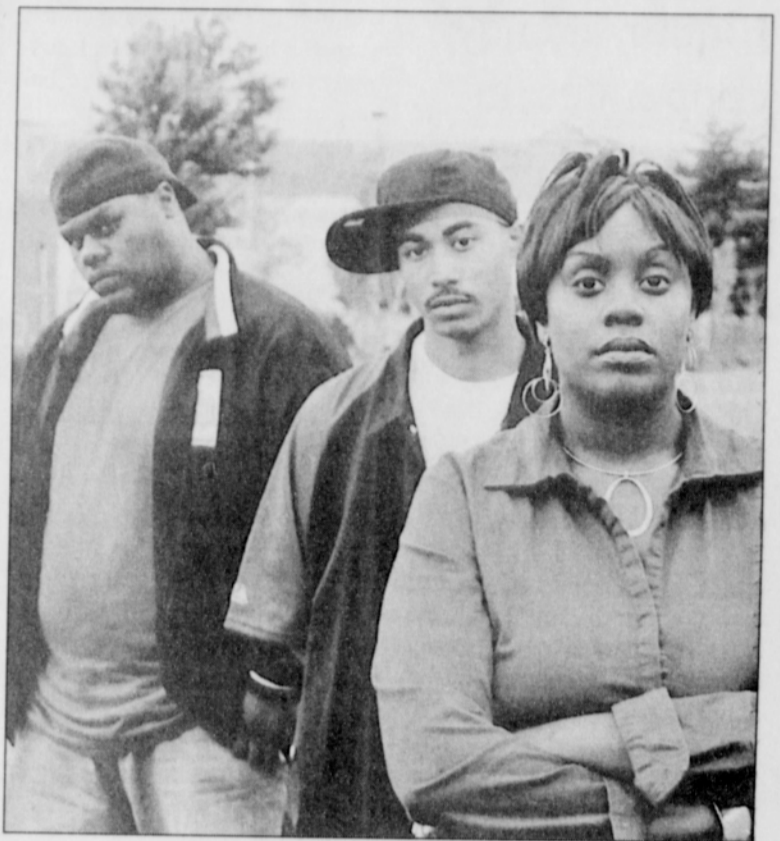

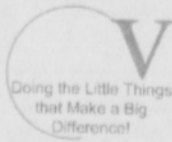
