

The project is a major renovation of two classrooms in Lawrence Hall on the University of Oregon Campus. The work includes typical interior renovation work, the infill of a steep tiered classroom with compacted fill and new tiered concrete floors, the installation of exterior windows in an existing wall, and the construction of a major ADA ramp.
