

His first recording in 1969 was at Vanco Recording Studio A one-night only birthday in Vancouver. The late blues man also gave him his first guitar lesson. His first major performance was a guest appearance with Buddy Guy

Band at Reed Common in 1965. Norman and B.B. King have the same birthday, 20 years apart.





