means a healthier meal, but healthier kids.

"Seeing them grow, knowing they're healthy, knowing their tummies are full is so satisfying," she said.

By garnering support from a

dozen local businesses and foundations, the Blazer Boys and Girls Club raised more than \$200,000 to renovate its cooking and serving area.

When the kitchen started out in 2000, it could only serve between 150 and 200 children a day. Now, with its size tripled, up to

500 meals can be served. This helps make Kids Café one of the nation's largest free meal service programs for children, with more than 1,000 in operation across the United States.

Also locally, the Wattles Boys and Girls Club in the Lents neighborhood of southeast Portland

opened a Kids Café in July 2004 and plans are set to open one next year at the Hillsboro Boys and Girls Club.

Leaf Recycling Depots Opening This Weekend

The city's popular leaf depots open this Saturday and run every weekend through Saturday, Dec. 10. Leaf depots are leaf recycling sites where residents can bring their yard leaves for a nominal fee. The depots rotate between six various

sites throughout the city and are open both Saturday and Sunday (with the exception of the last weekend) between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Only leaves will be accepted and only on the scheduled depot days. No other yard debris is allowed.

The Leaf Depot locations are: Cathedral Park at St. Johns boat ramp area at end of N. Baltimore; Floyd Light School at S.E. 108th and Washington; Gabriel Park at S.W. 42nd at Vermont, upper parking lot; Lents Park at S.E. 88th and Holgate, west side parking lot; Stanton Yard

at 2929 N. Kerby West of Emanuel Hospital; and Westmoreland Park at S.E. 22nd and Nehalem, parking lot by baseball field. For additional information, call the City's Leaf line at 823-1784 or go to the transportation website at www.trans.ci.portland.or.us.
