2005 GT Coupe

The 2005 Ford Mustang GT (V-8) coupe, look, feel, and deliver the American iconic heritage of The new "unitized welded steel" chassis for the 2005 Ford Mustang with complimentary new rear suspension and MacPherson struts is the basis for the mantra, the preferred GT V-8, 4.6-liter SOHC 3 valves per cylinder variable camshaft timing produces 300hp @ 5,750 rpm.

Mustang's cockpit also earns a make-over with new accessories like chrome gauge rings and alumi-

num trim panels, while an optional color-configured instrument cluster brings 125 color choices for backlighting of dashboard gauges. More standard equipment is aboard, such as one-touch up/down power windows, a keyless entry system and power locks.

Two powertrains motivate the new Mustang. Standard plant is a new 4.0-liter V6 for the base model pumping 210-hp.



Mustang GT stocks a 4.6-liter V8 ripper pushing 300-hp. 5-speed manual transmissions are standard. The V8 has a Tremec 3650

gearbox, while the V6 uses a Tremec T5. Optional is a 5-speed Standard modern safety features include sensing adjusted

dual-stage driver and front passenger airbags for full or partial deployment; with optional side-seat mounted air bags and front/

rear outboard three point shoulder/lap belts.
