The immediate object of these proceedings is to determine dependency and temporary care, custody, supervision and physical placement of your child.

Preliminary hearing will be held on above case number at **9:00 a.m.** on the **7th day of February, 2006**, before the court at the Snohomish County Juvenile Justice Center, 2801 10th Street, Everett, Washington 98201, for the purpose of appointment of attorneys, the determination of any facts not in dispute and the hearing of pre-trial motions; and fact finding hearings (trials) will be held before the said court on the above cause numbers at **9:00 a.m.** on the **23rd day of February, 2006**.

THE ABOVE NAMED INDIVIDUALS ARE SUMMONED TO APPEAR at both of said hearings regarding your child. If you do not appear at the first (preliminary) hearing, the court may cancel the second hearing and take evidence and enter an order without further notice to you. You may be held responsible for the support of the child if the child is placed in out-of-home care.

At all stages of a proceeding in which a child is alleged to be dependent pursuant to RCW 13.34.030 (2), the child's parent or guardian has the right to be represented by counsel, and if indigent, to have counsel appointed for him or her by the court.

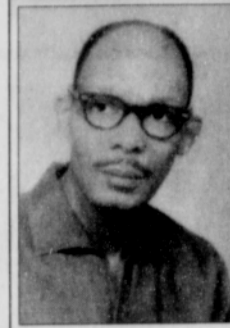
