THE ABOVE NAMED INDIVIDUALS ARE SUMMONED TO APPEAR at both of said hearings regarding your child. If you do not appear at the first (preliminary) hearing, the court may cancel the second hearing and take evidence and enter an order without further notice to you. You may be held responsible for the support of the child if the child is placed in out-of-home care.

At all stages of a proceeding in which a child is alleged to be dependent pursuant to RCW 13.34.030 (2), the child's parent or guardian has the right to be represented by counsel, and if indigent, to have counsel appointed for him or her by the court.

Qualifications are requested from qualified professional teams for the provision of design services for the HOPE VI redevelopment of Iris Court. The Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) will accept Qualifications until 3:00 PM, Thursday, December 22, 2005 at the HAP offices - 5th Floor, 135 SW Ash Street, Portland, Oregon 97204. Qualifications should be clearly marked with the respondent's name and address and the RFQ title and number. HAP will select up to four of the most qualified professional teams who will then participate in a subsequent RFP process for final selection of one design team.

The contemplated work for this project includes removing all of the existing structures, on-site improvements, a public street and public utilities, replacing all or most of the infrastructure, and constructing approximately 129 units of housing and 10,000 square feet of community space, management offices and service provider space located in a mixed use building. Construction work is expected to begin in April 2007.

After the subsequent RFP process, HAP will select one design team to perform the scope of services, which includes master planning for the entire site, securing all necessary permits, providing full architectural services for the housing and mixed-use building and site improvements

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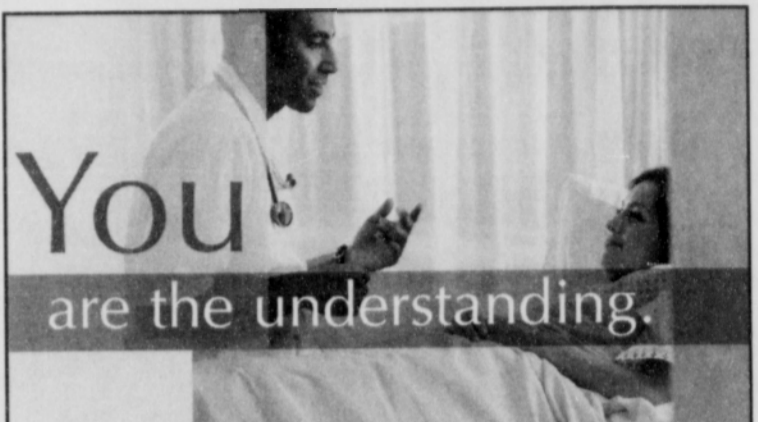

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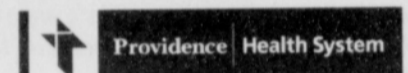
