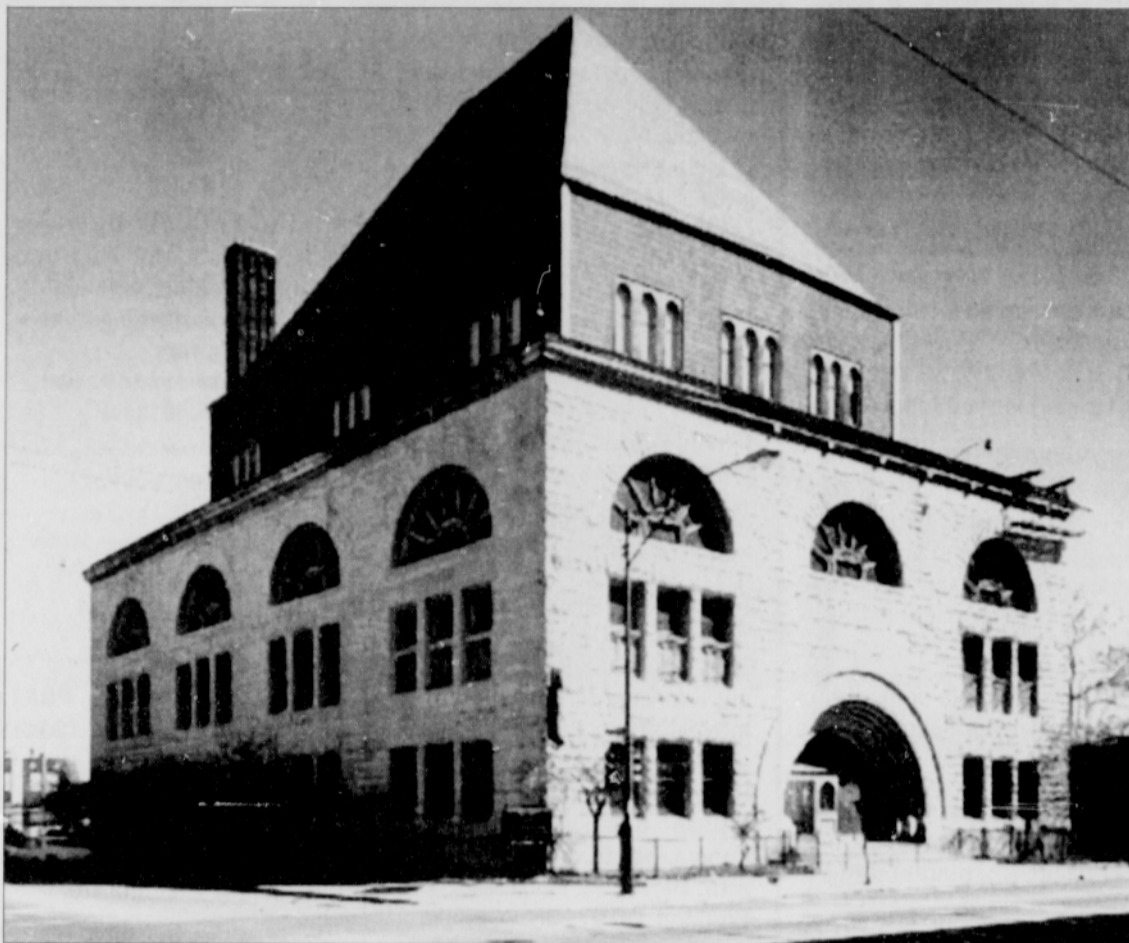
Fire Destroys Historic Church

Fire destroyed a landmark 1890 church Friday on Chicago's South Side that played a major role in the development of gospel music in the 1930s.

The roaring fire engulfed the Pilgrim Baptist Church and collapsed the church's roof and gutted its inside. No injuries were reported. The cause of the fire was not immediately known.

Designed by the distinguished architect Louis Sullivan and his partner, the church was built between 1890 and 1891. It was originally a synagogue but had housed the church since 1922.

During the 1930s, the African American congregation and its longtime music director, Thomas A. Dorsey, were instrumental in the development of gospel music. Among those who sang at the church was Gospel music sensation Mahalia Jackson.



An archive photo shows the historic Pilgrim Baptist Church in Chicago.

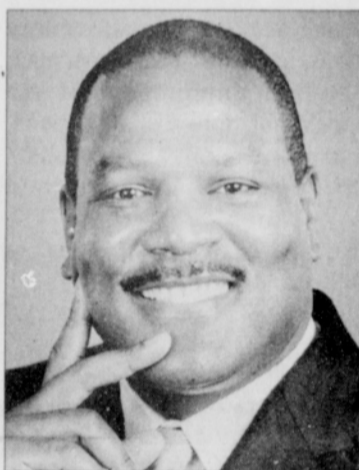
Downtown Church Celebrates King Legacy
