Retherford competed in the Bantam Division (nine to 10 years old) and jumped 4.56 meters, or 14 feet 11.75 inches, to break the long-standing mark of 4.48 meters in this event. He also participated in the 100 and 400-meter dashes, winning the 100-meter with a time of 13.54 seconds and placing second in the 400 meters with a time of 1:04.1 seconds.

This was the first meet of the season for Retherford, and he is looking forward to more exceptional performances as



the 2006 season unfolds.

Retherford finished the 2005 season as a National medalist in the long jump at the National Junior Olympic Championships in Indianapolis, Ind. He also qualified in the 100 and 400-meter dashes.


